

methodically coordinated, the conclusions drawn in each chapter forming the links of the heavy chain of logic that points out the causes of the fluctuations and of the fall in prices. Not the least impertant consideration is the fact that this is the first work of the kind that has appeared in the last thirty years. This book fills up the void created since the last publication of Tooke and Newmarch's History of Prices in 1855. To quote the author's words, "it may appear surprising that so long a period has been allowed to pass without a review of the trade of nations in connection with the rise and fall of prices, but the magnitude of the undertaking has possibly deterred many competent persons.
