

Saturday, April 12th. The market opened this morning firm as rock, and prices at once rose. This being Saturday, and very many people believing gold to be very dear, sold during the week for to-day, counting on the sale of the Western Railway and the probable negotiation of the much-talked of London loan. Thus the delivery of gold was heavy, and much had to be bought at the first ring, which pushed cash prices up to 315; but at that figure the market turned and dropped gently eight points, when it again grew firm. There was great talk on 'Change about gold "conformes," and only those of probable that next week we shall see the market swept clean of these documents, which already give rise to questions and disputes. The exact amount out in the market no one seems to know, but in a few

days we shall all know. The excitement in the hall was not so feverish as yesterday, and apparently now market has becom reconciled to the inevitable. This accounts for the little anxiety periences and prognostications, yet matters are as quiet and tranquil as if it were a there cannot be the slightest doubt, Our official colleagues may be deceived by the superficial severity of affairs, and think that the advance of the premium is a matter of little moment and less importance. The eckoning must come; it is approachng now with giant strides, and despite the spicious calm that has blinded the offiial eyes to the danger, there is a sapping at work that will cause little short of widespread panic when the edifice begins to rumble. For those who are versed in financial me enology, there are signs not o be mistaken of the coming hurricane. he credit tether is shortening every day, and we can have no surer sign of the near approach of the "dies iræ" of the crisis.

Business at the first hour embraced the ale of close on half a million gold dollars eash, the rate opening at 308, fluctuating for some time between 312 and 315, then weakening off to 306, after which it reacted again to 312 and closed at 309. The fluctuation tuation was thus very violent almost all during the hour, and although little was done on time, quotations shewed a similar state of oscillation.
