BUENOS AYRES, TUESDAY, APRIL 22 1890.

Fuller details are anxiously awaited, but so far, all accounts agree in stating that, at least, two hundred persons perished at Louisville last night.

Many places in Illinois, Missouri and Indiana report some fatalities. The fall of hail was in some parts most severe. Cincinnati and St. Louis were deluged. Dispatches from Greenville, Mississippi, report that a heavy storm of wind prevailed there all day yesterday, and the water was constantly washing over the levees. The storm was raging with increased fury when the latest dispatchs were sent, and the situation was pronounced to be critical.

A great disaster was feared, as it was thought that the levees would be unable to stand the great strain of the wash of the flood-tide from the street of the wind. At Nashville, Illinois, the City Hall and other buildings were demolished by the tornado, and at Carbonale, in the same State, a train was blown off the track, and some houses were demolished. Three persons are reported to have been killed there.

Storms of wind, hail and snow are signalled generally from the North-West. Heavy snows have fallen in Minnesota and Dakota, and all at Tarkenton measuring twelve inches.

New York, March 25th (later). A train which left Louisville shortly after the tornado burst over the place has reached Louisville. The officials report that the loss of life will probably be found to amount to eight hundred.

The guard says he was dining at an hotel at eight o'clock last evening, when suddenly a terrible crashing and roaring was heard. All the diners rushed to the street. The air was filled with bricks, slates, dust and debris of all kinds. An inky darkness prevailed, but soon long shafts of flame lighted the scene, while from the ruins, cries, shrieks and wailings were heard. The hotel was blown down and the wreck had caught fire. From the midst of the ruin appeared the forms of a man, a woman and a child, who cried piteously for help, saying that they were wedged in the ruins. The man and woman could not move. Nothing could be done to assist them, and the unhappy creatures perished in the sight of hundreds of people.

The gas and electric lighting plants are wrecked, and the city was all last night in absolute darkness, broken only by the flames proceeding from the burning houses. It is thought that the waterworks have also been reduced to something approaching ruin. Every moment brings fresh news of accidents at different towns. Street cars have been blown from the tracks and crushed against buildings.

New York, March 25th (9.30 a.m.). All telegraphic communication with Louisville is still interrupted; hence it is impossible to obtain definite details of the disaster.

SUNDAY'S RACING.

As expected, the meeting at Belgrano proved interesting in the extreme, and the attractions of the programme being assisted by beautiful weather, there was the best attendance so far, of the year. The greatest animation reigned, and there was no single instance of any kind to mar the pleasures of the day.

The first grandee and police and other rescuers were greatly hindered by the multitude surrounding the ruins, and they had a difficult task in removing from the spot the women, who were digging at the debris with their fingers, each with grief at the groans beneath, each of which they thought came from their friends. The scene is said to be a deplorable one, and some of the houses are reported to have been killed there.

Scores of bodies were removed, and the injured were taken to the homes of those who were spared. The bodies were most severe in the business district, and substantial stores were destroyed in an instant. The tornado entered the town from the south and west, sweeping every thing before it. Small bars and outbuildings were blown down, and the larger structures were twisted off short and hurled long distances. Every church and other prominent building was destroyed or badly damaged. The population of Matropoli numbers 4,000. Telegrams continue to be received reporting tornadoes, high winds, torrential rains, snow and hail from the various parts of the State. The bodies were reported from several localities with here and there many fatalities and cases of injuries. The wind travelled with frightful velocity, throwing down the telegraph poles, and blowing down the telegraph poles, and causing great delay to traffic.

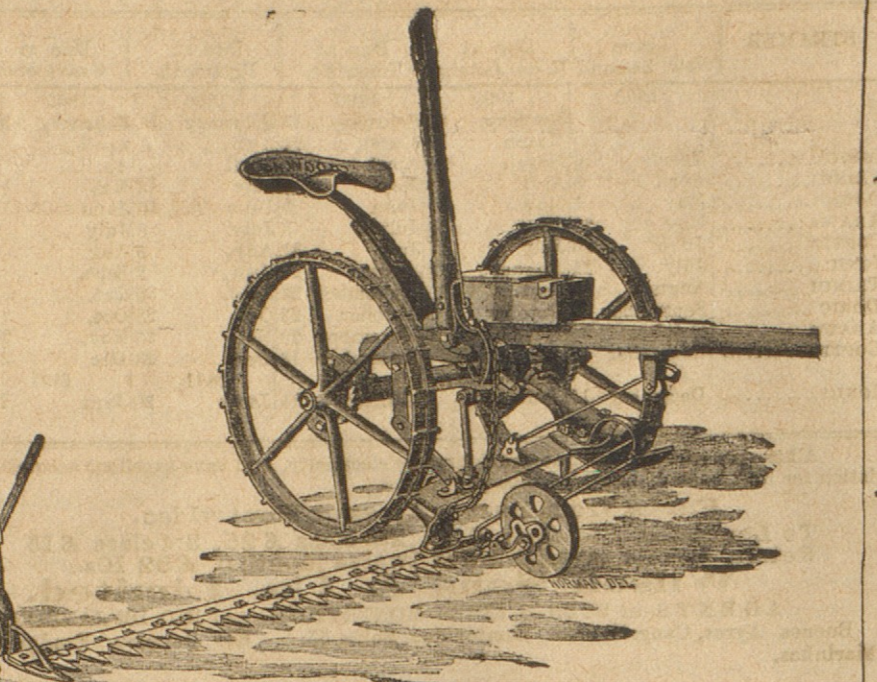
