

Not for the tightness of the money market. Thus the old saying again holds true. Mr. Murray, the active manager, has resolved to adopt the good old English system of interim dividends whereby quarterly instalments are in future to be handed over to the holders of scrip instead of hoarding up the profit for a grand yearly dividend as a usual practice in this country. The same admirable spirit prevails throughout the entire administration from the manufacture of the gas to the collection of the monthly accounts and even the staff is turned to good account. How different would be the condition of things in general were this improved handling like system more generally adopted by all industrial companies working in our midst? But Rome was not built in a day, nor can every joint stock concern secure the services of an able and painstaking manager as Mr. Estrada's successor has proved to be.

We extract the following from the exchange article of a London colleague to hand by the mail :—

“ The foreign Government stock market is firm, in sympathy with Paris and Berlin,

Argentine and Uruguay excepted. Portuguese bonds shared in the steadiness, these being held—luckily for English investors—mainly on the Continent. Argentine and Buenos Aires Cédulas are $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 lower, and sterling bonds are also down about 1.

A long meeting of the Argentine Commission took place to-day, and a further meeting will be held to-morrow. The feeling was spread that matters are likely to be regulated with the smoothness and ability that might be expected from the character

of the excellent men of business who compose the Commission. The immediate difficulty is the paper currency. There is at once too much and too little, and its value is wholly regulated by sentiment, part from the occasional sales of large

pumps of currency by Government, when remittances have to be made in gold. Were it once understood that efforts were being made to sop up the superfluous money on the one hand, and to stop the necessity for large Government sales against gold, it is

very likely that the value of the currency would recover, and the rest might appear easy. Whether and to what extent the old coupons will have to be funded, we have yet to see. Two years' reprieve would

wonders.
