HAVAS

Paris, Jan. 4 (teleg.)—The elections for the third part of the Senate took place to-day throughout France. 62 Republicans and only 6 Conservatives were re-elected at the first scrutiny; there were 134 others. M. de Freycinet was re-elected by a large majority. M. Jules Ferry, who was defeated at the last election, is now successful in the Department of the Yonne.

Paris, Jan. 5.—The complete return shows the election of 75 Republicans and 6 Conservatives, the latter losing 10 seats held by them in the late Senate. This splendid Republican triumph has given rise to very lively commentary in the newspapers.

La Defensa del Pueblo, which makes its appearance with highly conservative ideas, will do its best to contribute to the organization of the people, not for the purpose of promoting revolutions or riots which might be prejudicial to the progress of the country, but for establishing a constitutional regime—recovery of the sovereignty of the country, which lives on the basis of the body only exists when that body is healthy, stable and disorganized, so, in like manner, the disorganization of the country can only have existence when the nation is disorganized.

Such are the ideas which we shall maintain in the columns of this paper, which calls for such bitter invective, and which gives birth to a paper that finds, at the first moment of its issue, such a widespread circulation.

The present Government is certainly responsible for this Danion journal. Public pacifism has been taxed to the very utmost by the resurrection of the free banks, which, when the Government ordered the closing of the same in August, were to all intents closed and the perpetrators of clandestine issues and of paper money brought to justice.

Since the fall of Rivadavia no greater political error has been perpetrated in this country than the resuscitation of those bankrupt banks whose doors should have been sealed up within 24 hours after the publication of Mr. Pillado's and other inventors' reports.
