Telégrafos.

London, 29th - Bank of England has re-  
solved to raise 30 millions.  
Rome, 29th - During the discussion of  
the budget deficit of 33 millions, the Min-  
ister of Finance proposed to parliament in-  
creased duties on spirits, oils, and drugs  
and banking stamps, etc. The Chamber  
of Deputies, however, is in favor of these  
proposals.

THE CHILIAN CIVIL WAR.  
For two generations the Chilean Repub-  
lic was a model in the South American de-  
mocracy. An oligarchy ruled with an iron  
hand and the people were tame. Wedged  
between the Andes and the Pacific  
Ocean, the narrow strip of Chilean terri-  
tory soon became too small for the normal  
development of the country, and the  
ideas of aggression, which were the  
basis of the Chilean conquest of Patagonia  
in the South and Tarapaca in the North,  
including what Argentina may term a  
"marito" of Bolivian territory at An-  
tofagasta. A pretext for war was found  
in the fact that Chilean troops were  
sent to fight, owing to the difficulty  
about the limits between the two countries,  
but the Chileans were wise in their genera-  
tion, and fled from the temptation of  
provoking Argentina; they thought better  
to provide the weaker for the North  
and relied on the very first pretext to  
wage war against Bolivia and Peru - a  
kind of international skirmish in an-  
ticipation of the more serious struggle  
with Argentina.

Payment of the Plan of the Mesagerías  
Flotillas (\$400,000), was arranged to be  
made by a cash payment of \$100,000, and

cumulation of years' depreciation would be  
sufficient to pay off these bills as they be-  
came due. Unfortunately, however, war

tion passed was \$25,544. These bills have

Chile is now the victim of a civil war  
that may last months, say years. It is  
well not to disguise the fact that Argentina  
need not weep over the fate of Chile in  
the present dire circumstances; but in the  
name of South America we must deplore  
that the solitary example of good govern-  
ment and orderly democracy in South  
America should rush into civil strife; for,  
let it be remembered that Chile has not  
to deal with a mere revolution. The present  
struggle has all the features of a civil war,  
in which it is difficult to see where the  
right lies, whether on the side of the  
President or of the rebellious Congress.  
All South American Republics, with the  
solitary exception of Brazil, are to-day  
convulsed by political or financial crises;  
and we are sorry to think that Brazil is  
also rushing into an express train into the  
same morose difficulties as this country.  
Only, it is a case of Poor South America  
with a vengeance.

advances and guarantees, the two firms re-

Every one knows what the state of the  
Argentine Republic has been, and as to

justly say as to correspond with the
