

ON 'CHANGE.

Tuesday, April 26. The weak feeling in the gold market is becoming faily more pronounced, but it is an excellent sign to see the premium sinking slowly, free from all panicky features and fluctuations. The whole market is following the bearish current at present. Over twenty thousand ounces changed hands at the first ring; the price opened at \$54.20, rose to 54.30, and closed heavy at 54.10, say 2321 olo premium. Two thousand sovereigns were sold; the price opened at \$16.85 and closed weak at 16.80, say 2331 olo premium. The supply of so-called produce gold appears to be falling off, as the fall in the premium is calculated to premium beginning the calculated to paralyze business in the produce markets. Consignees and farmers are grumbling at the daily appreciation of paper money, a process that necessarily puts down the paper prices of produce. The buyer neces-sarily operates on a gold basis, and cares little whether gold falls or rises, unless he speculates in his business; ut the seller, in other words, the conmee, or the farmer, operates on a per basis, and looks upon a fall in the premium as nothing short of a onvince him of the contrary. There-ore, a sharp and steady fall in gold always bears a disastrous effect on the produce markets. Patriotic Bonds ruled dull, but steady, l morning; about fifty thousand were ld, closing at 59.60 for cash, 59.70 for -morrow, and 60 for the middle of ext month. It is strange that this stock should be quoted firm for the end and middle of next month, since the subscription to the first series of the capital of the Banco de la Nacion, which causes a demand for same, ex-470 Calle Urquiza. Banco de la Nacion Arge remark that the progres frame of mind of the public may perhaps arise from a conviction that the sub cription to the second series of the Bank's capital may be effected under cheaper conditions than at present. It may, however, happen that Congress, in view of the unsatisfactory results of Wedding Dresses. Walking Dresses. Travelling Dresses he subscription to the first series of ne ten millions, will think fit to limit he capital of the new Bank to half or one quarter the amount originally fixed La Plata Cedulas were slightly weakr to-day: the closing rates were 29 for closed at 29.60. What keeps up the

price of Cedulas is the general process of cancelling mortgages going on at present on a heavy scale. This cancelling process, however, has its limits at preent prices, and when it begins to fall off a decline in Cedulas must ensue. There re many who argue that Cedulas must fall to 25 and lower, but there are a few who maintain that the stock will always be worth one third of its value. Sooner r later the Provincial Government will e obliged to come to some agreement with the Cedula holders and make some ompromise at 25 or 50% of the full va-ue of the stock; it is whispered that neotiations have already been opened in his respect and that an agent has ar-ived from London, but the report is ot believed and it sounds premature at present. It would appear, however, from the frequency of these rumors, that there is something in the wind.

Shares were quite neglected this morning. National Bank shares have vanished from the Board; with regard to this once sovereign stock, there is some curiosity to know what will become of the shares or receipts of shares, signed by Dr. Victorino de la Plaza, which were sent out here under the belief that they could be exchanged for Patriotic Bonds at the rate of 2 to 1. The holders of these shares must now know their fate; some, we hear, have bought the shares of the Banco de la Nacion;

Board of the Co-operative Gas Company which was bought out by the Argentine Gas Company. The shareholders of the o-operative Gas Company are groping the dark and are amazed to see hat their shares are utterly worthless works at the Corrales.
