

THE MUNICIPAL MORTUORIO.

Sept. 3rd. We are indebted to a communication by Mr. Alberto Martinez in yesterday's Monitor for the conditions of the Mortuorio recently concluded by the Municipal Corporation. The London debt is in default since 1880, and the bondholders have consented to take 15 per cent for the interest coupons for the second half-year of 1892, and 50 per cent from the beginning of next year.

Although the receipts in 1891 averaged only \$800,000 a month they are calculated next year to reach \$1,000,000 monthly, in which case the quota payable to the London bondholders will be \$300,000 monthly, or \$3,600,000 per annum.

The revenue and expenditure of the Municipality in the last two years were as follows: Receipts, \$10,194,000; Expenditure, \$10,000,000.

Mr. Carlos Guerrero, the active and energetic promoter of the League, opened proceedings with a speech in which he explained the conditions of the League.
