IMPORT DUES IN CONGRESS.
The public will read with indignation that the resolutions voted by the Senate in the Customs tariff for 1893 have been for the most part rejected by the Deputies. The upper Chamber for example reduced the duty on raw sugar from 70% to 50% gold per ton, and on refined sugar from 90% to 70% gold, both of which reductions are thrown out. This is a tremendous loss to the welfare of the country, since it adds 20% per ton to the price of this commodity, the consumption of which reaches 70,000 tons yearly. Thus the extra burthen imposed on the public is 14,000,000 gold or 4,000,000 currency. It was stated by deputy Garcia in the course of the debate that the suggested 120% gold per ton paid in France, 90% in Germany and 190% in Italy, and we regret that we are not in a position to test the accuracy of this statement.

But it is quite immaterial what the sugar duty may be in Germany or in Japan, since Congress has to legislate for the Argentine Republic, and the reduction proposed by the Senate was a becoming concession to public opinion, which the Deputies would have been wise to adopt.

Among other alterations the Senate proposed to admit fencing-wire and ploughs free, but we are on principle opposed to special favors of this kind to any industry, and see no reason why ploughs should enjoy an exemption refused to sheep-shears.

There is, happily, a reduction of 4 cents or two pence English per gallon on some wine, which is a relief to the working-classes, as it implies a saving of 4,000,000 gold in the cost, the ordinary consumption being 24 million gallons yearly. We could have wished for a much greater reduction, but what matter, since the Deputies did not rather increase the wine-dues.

We observe, also, a reduction on hats, which is an item of minor importance, and the total abolition of duty on printed books, all at the same time a tremendous duty is imposed on printing-paper, to favor the patriotic gentlemen of Zarate. This we have nothing short of a public outrage in a Government professing the principles of equality of taxation heavily the raw material (paper) and allows the manufactured article (books) to come in free of duty.

In order to cultivate friendly relations with Paraguay the duty on tobacco from that afflicted country is raised to 90% gold per ton. The value of Paraguayan tobacco before shipment is about 50% gold per ton, and the duty now imposed by the Argentine tariff is 10 times that sum. Let us hope there is a sympathetic resolution in the resolution passed by Congress, and that instead of 50 cents per kilo it ought to be 5 cents per kilo: a latter would be 50% per ton, equal to a duty of 100 per cent.

GUNPOWDER.
There has been for some days a small of "villainous salpeters" in the air, and the symptoms of coming troubles increase. The instruction in Corrientes is the latest alarming news of this kind, and, as usual, inoffensive persons are said to have been murdered in cold blood. Hundreds of gauchos have thrown up the poncho, and it seems probable that the province will be for some time over-run with bands of armed men, unless the National Government send troops to restore order.

On the other side of the river Uruguay the Brazilian province of Rio Grande is converted into a pandemonium; murder, rapine and civil war are spreading on all sides, and threaten sooner or later to involve the Banda Oriental. If by any chance a war were to take place between Brazil and Uruguay it would inevitably compel Argentine troops to take the field, and such a war would probably last for years.

Affairs would be additionally complicated if Chile were to make an alliance with Brazil, in which event Bolivia and Peru would seize the occasion to join forces with the Argentine Republic.

Poor South America! Mr. Sarmentino was quite right in saying that there is a general loss in all the Spanish American republics. Their internal government, as a rule, is exceedingly bad; their relations with their neighbors are so unsatisfactory that they ensue every three or four years. Time brings no improvement, experience teaches no wisdom.

We hear everybody of purchases of Winchester or Mauser rifles, smokeless powder, Krupp guns or new iron clad. One would imagine that all the despotic autocrats were armed with military matters. There is, moreover, hardly a republic in South America which has not a long list of Generals.

Meantime peace is the great requirement of the country, for with it we can have no progress. Already the taxes and burthens that press upon the people of Argentina and neighboring States are excessive. Moas of these taxes are called for by reason of large military and naval establishments, which are three or four times greater than are needed.

MAILS FROM CHILE.
Valparaiso, Dec. 17th.
His Excellency the President of the Republic on Friday evening entertained the ex-President of Bolivia, don Aniceto Arce, at a splendid banquet in his official residence in the Monsinos. The head of the table was taken by President Montt, having on his right the chief of the evening and on his left the Chamber of Deputies, don Julio Zegers. Fronting his Excellency sat the Argentine Minister, don Manuel de Goyena, followed by the Argentine Ambassador, don Antonio de Barros Lasso.

The U. S. Squadron, consisting of the Baltimore, Boston, San Francisco and Charleston, arrived yesterday afternoon, and shortly after anchoring salutes were exchanged with the fort and the Chilean flagship Cochrane.

The Government ontologist reports that he has found the Argentine locust known as the saltona, in the Province of Biobio. Fortunately, he adds, there are not many. Near Los Noivos he found an "ensidia" infested with the insect, and he killed the greater number of them. The native insect is abundant and destructive, and

mixed with it are some Argentine locusts. In a journey of 45 leagues on both banks of the Biobio from San Carlos de Puren to the Cordillera Blanca, he saw some insects which appeared to be the Argentine species, but they had changed so much in form and color as to make him dubious with respect to the species. Eminent owners are much alarmed in consequence of the losses they sustained, but there is still a good deal of gold, the danger is not so great as it is at first sight appears. The Argentine locust has not approached very closely the cordillera this year, and the probability is that there will not be an invasion of the insect. Nevertheless competent persons will be sent to Villa Rica and Lonquima Passes to observe and report.

A letter from Sandy Point, 8th says that the Tierra del Fuego gold miners as follows:
"The Huemel landed 22 sick and distressed miners, and reports were received that things do not look bright at all. There is a very great shortage of labor, but not sufficient to satisfy such a great number of men as there are now on these islands, and it is feared that there will be much misery before long, chiefly when the winter approaches."

We regret to announce the death of Mr. Daniel Robertson, an old resident of Ercilla.

Mr. Robertson, who had been in declining health for some time, died on the 18th shortly after his return from Concepcion, where he had been to consult a doctor. He was a prominent figure among Railway men in the South, where he had been for many years. He will be most known for the bridge over the Malleco River at Collipulli, which being one of the highest bridges in the world, as well as one of the handsomest, will always remain a suitable monument to his memory and skill as a man.

Mr. Robertson's first contract with the Government of Chile was dated the 7th July 1868, and he has been employed under government ever since, working first on the breakwaters at Valparaiso, as master mason, and in a similar capacity to the hour of his death.

He was a Scotchman and a native of Inverness. His widow is a native of Chile, and accompanied him in his only visit to his native land since his first engagement under the government of Chile.

LATEST FROM CHILE.
MR. JUFFEN'S PAMPHLET CONDEMNED.
The following telegram was received yesterday from Santiago, Chile:
Santiago, Dec. 25th.—Public opinion has received quite a shock at the news from B. Ayres. Yesterday the Foreign Affairs Minister called for a secret ally of the Deputies to publish a pamphlet signed by Minister Guerrero.

The Union of Valparaiso in an article headed "Summer Showers" issued an "Unimply published" issue, with the title "Unimply published." The pamphlet has almost obscured the tranquil atmosphere of our relations with Argentina. We allude to the pamphlet published by Mr. Bianchi-Tupper, in B. Ayres, a pamphlet which appears to have been published with the consent of Minister Guerrero. This pamphlet has raised a storm in B. Ayres, and almost burst over the coat of arms of the Chilean Legation in the Plaza.

The pamphlet is a very pamphlet by a private individual was most uncalled for, but issued by a person invested with an official charge it merits the severest censure. We do not think, however, that the Governor should be attacking our legation and we are glad to see that the excitement of the first moment has altogether subsided. It has passed away like a summer-shower. The only thing wanting is the Minister's withdrawal of it, to give peace to the Chilean nation should be made responsible for such blunders. Minister Guerrero cannot remain in B. Ayres. He must retire, and the Argentine press state that he is about to retire.

THE CORRIENTES REVOLUTION.
According to the latest advices from Corrientes, the Governor has ordered the suspension of the newspapers, from which circumstance it is inferred that H. E. cannot have very pleasant news to give the public. The steamer Lafont left on Christmas Day from Corrientes for Bella Vista. There are 60 armed men on board. One hundred men were seen on the 24th day at Bella Vista, the frontier town of the Argentine Republic. On the other hand the revolutionists are by no means inactive. Martinez sent 400 men in boats from Goys to take Bella Vista, and an encounter is therefore imminent. It appears that the Governor has asked the Union Civilia to support him, promising to reopen the electoral register for the inscription of voters of that political color. This promise sufficiently paints the electoral situation in Corrientes. The Union Civilia refused to have anything to do with the Governor. In the meantime the greatest anxiety prevails in the town of Corrientes, and people hope the National Government will interfere to prevent bloodshed.

The Revolutionists hope to have some eight thousand men in a few days, that is to say four thousand more than they have at present. Corruza-Castin has expected that the Government will send the hands of the revolutionists. The authorities in that town have only 40 rifles and a few hundred lances.

Last Wednesday there appears to have been considerable excitement in Esquina, by the news that a vessel had left Corrientes with armed men to take Esquina. The citizens gathered on the bank of the river and patiently waited for the vessel to arrive. She arrived in due time but kept at a prudent distance from the bank and eventually cleared.

Com. Martinez expresses his intention of marching on Corrientes. The Governor is concentrating troops between San Roque and Bella Vista. It was said yesterday that Nuffez, who commands the Government forces, had the throats of five men cut in San Roque. Co. Insuasturza at the head of 150 revolutionists is marching on Caseros.

Telegrams from Concordia report the arrest of Blanco, the famous Corrientes "caudillo," who tried to get up a revolution in that province some months ago. The news of his arrest caused great indignation and a public meeting is being organized to protest against the outrage. This Entre Rios Government is much blamed for the meddling in the affairs of Corrientes.

THE ESTANCIA MARTIN CHICO.
A VISIT TO MR. JAMES WATSON BELL'S ESTATE.
I shall endeavor to condense into this letter all the notes I had occasion to write in regard to the estancia, for as the title I have been going to write took me so much time to write, it would take me too long to write a description. Therefore I shall skip over drives and picnics and excursions "nube canyon," which I shall always recall with delight, and proceed to give a few particulars of the estancia. The estancia Martin Chico was bought by Mr. James Watson Bell 27 years ago. It was not an estancia then. It was wild woodland and undulating camp with a "hacienda" here and there. Mr. Watson Bell was fortunate enough to select an able, energetic and excellent manager, Mr. James McCulloch, who began by putting on a few sheep and building a house, which subsequently acquired the name of "hacienda" of the present edifice. He was fenced part of the camp and subsequently divided the estancia, which covers something over three square leagues, into fifteen large ranches and a number of small ones. The dimensions of the present edifice would be established at all the wire-fencing on the estate: I should say that there must be over 50 miles of fencing. There is no doubt that the estate has been singularly favored by nature, for there are less than five places where vessels are regularly used, and the soil appears to be of boundless fertility. Mr. McCulloch, with great foresight, began to plant, or "montear," on the open part of the estate. These groves wonderfully improve the aspect of the estancia, to which they give the appearance of an English park, while they afford shade in summer and shelter in winter to the cows, horses and other stock. The shade of the trees is particularly large, and it is not infrequently noted eight of these "montes," some larger than others, mostly of gum-trees. There are, however, "montes" of cypresses and other trees, while in the neighborhood of the house oaks and ash trees are to be seen. The estates only know the immense advantages—not to say anything of the pleasing aspect, of these "montes," they would begin at once to plant trees. The only grove of trees is the "monte" of Mr. McCulloch began with an ounce of seed twelve years ago. Today the estancia is studded here and there with fine groves. Mr. McCulloch continues to plant "montes" of all the kinds of trees, which he has planted in the camp. It is an incipient "monte." The trees are planted with the maize, which grows up more rapidly and protects the young trees. Of course there is a large tract of wild "montes" stretching along the beach, and here you find large fanpalms, which supply an excellent fuel for the "tambarani," from which the "cal," the wild fig-tree, the wild orange tree, the weeping-willow, the leccio, from which the Indians used to make their canoes, and which has a lovely red flower, the "tambarani," from which poles are made, the "amarrillo," and other kinds of tree, mostly useful. All this wild "monte" is being gradually cleared away at a great cost, to make room for the "hacienda." There are now upon three thousand acres of making, waving wheat-fields, and you could hardly believe that these plantations stand where an impenetrable "monte" once thrived. The open, unending groves of the wild "montes" are being cleared for agriculture. Mr. Watson Bell supplies the land and the implements and machinery. The farmer tills the soil and grows the wheat, half the yield he keeps for himself. The other half he sends to the estancia, which is a much heavier article, so hardly indeed that they say it thrives and fattens upon what the latter leaves. All the Herefords, in spite of the great drought, are in sleek and excellent condition. There is a large herd of Herefords, and there you see immense smoking-mounds, where the trunks and roots are being reduced to charcoal, which is sent to Buenos Ayres.
