The Corrientes revolution i merely a sequel to that in Santiago del Estero; very soon all the provinces will be steeped in blood. Yet the Arntine Constitution empathically forbids the raising of armies by the provinces unless provided with special permission of the National Government or Congress. The greatest legal lights in the country sit in the Cabinet, but appear t ignore the country's constitution, the covenant they have sworn to respect and enforce. The confidence


