Some members of the Cabinet do not like the policy of allowing Correntinos to arm and kill each other, as the example is per nicious and may lead to similar patriotic outbreaks in other provinces. Under hese influences the gold market opened in a very bullish mood this morning, but the rise did not last long, and long before the bell rang the speculation had fallen away and the premium droppet two to three points.
