FIRST RING 215.80% SECOND RING..... 216.20% This was a very active morning in the old market. Already last night it was

known in speculative quarters that a heavy supply of gold would come down like a sledgehammer on the ring to-day, and a bearish feeling in consequence was rampant in the hall. But the news from Chile announcing the passage of the Bill for mobilizing the Chilian militia spoiled the fun and upset calculations. There is not the slightest doubt that this Chilian mobilization has produced an awkward impression in all quarters and is viewed

with much suspicion even by those who indulged in optimism a tew hours ago.

Fortunately, the supply of cash gold this morning was abnormally heavy, and this cted as a brake upon the rising tendency of the premium. As matters fell out, the premium fell, but considering the amoun gold banged away the fall was insigni ficant. Many parties stepped into the ring to-day and began buying on time in spite of the stiff contango. Others who gave orders yesterday to sell gold cancelled the orders to-day in view of the

unsatisfactory news from the West Coast. Meantime the news that the Argentine Government have to their credit in Lonlon two millions sterling has excited much attention in the market and is calculated to improve affairs. In the market there has been all along a suspicion that the Government must enter the ring to buy gold and take exchange to meet the service on the debt, the advances of bankers and the purchase of so much war-material. The announcement, therefore, that the Treasury has such a large amount of money to its credit in London has caused agreeable surprise and increased the awe with which our Financial ed the awe with which our Financial Sphinx is surrounded in the eyes of the market. It would be interesting to know how Minister Romero has managed to tide over the last twelve months: in London and Berlin they know more of this than we do here.

Over a million gold dollars changed hands at the first ring: of this amount about seven hundred thousand dollars were chalked up for cash: the premium opened in a bearish mood at 216.20%, fell to 215.70%, rose under a very sharp demand to 216.40%, fell again, and closed at 215.80%. This being the weekly settlement the cash requirement were much above the average, but the supply of specie was superabundant. Two hundred thousand dollars were sold for the good of the mounts; the premium the end of the mounth: the premium opened at 218 ½ %, rose to 219 % and closed at 218 ½ %. One hundred and fifty thousand dollars were sold for the fortnightly settlement, the premium closed at 216 ½ %. A small amount was sold for the end of March: the premium opened at 222%. rose to 222 ½ %, and closed at 222%.
