All the furniture and goods of all kinds pitched and carried into the street through fear of the fire spreading were generously allowed to be stored in the large Teneriffe Cigar Divan of Messrs Morales and Son, 333 Piedad, opposite the Bolsa. It was the only house open in the street at the time, except a hair-dresser's, the proprietor of which most uncharitably closed his doors and refused to allow even a chair to be placed in it. This Good Samaritan won't have increased the number of his customers in the "barrio" by this conduct on such a distressing occasion.

Second Ring..... 196.30 Naturally, the engrossing topic of conversation to-day was the explosion which shook the whole Bolsa block yesterday. The Temple was pretty clear when it occurred, as even the usual late birds, frightened away by the weather, had left. To-day the particulars thereof were avidly discussed, and we may put it down that the explanation of the box having contained an assortment of rockets is not accepted, the prevalent impression being that the explosive was dynamite, pure and simple. That the loss of life was so small is little short of wonderful. Mr. small is little short of wonderful. Mr. Miles Pasman, who was sitting in his offices dead in front of the scene of the disaster, felt the concussion go right through the building, though nothing really suffered except the windows. Mr. Robinson, liquidator of the ex-English Bank of the River Plate, only a few yards higher up the street, also felt the shock very plainly in his offices in the B. Ayres Insurance building, which had the big plate glass windows shivered, and he had to stay on till all danger of the fire had to stay on till all danger of the fire lapping across from the almacen to the houses in front was over. All the brokers and merchants visited the scene to-day, the crowd in the block being tremendous till thinned off by the rain; and we may say that more interest was manifested in the details of the disaster than in the gold speculation, which still drags out a weary, heavy, monotonous length. The market finding that gold will not respond to a bullish speculation, has now taken a crossed-arms attitude. Speculate for a fall it will not. perhaps from disinclination, perhaps from apprehension, but so it is, and with prices threatening a collapse the ring is firm as ever in its "trece" that gold is cheap. Business is at a standstill in every line, and exchange tottering. The prospects, therefore, are not a prospective promise, even though the gold

prices keep down.

'The business in gold at the first hour was considerably below the average, due to the bagatelle nature of transactions for dates, the gross total being only 674,100 dollars, of which cash sales absorbed over a third. The pass contracted very markedly, being done at less than a point for the end of the month and less than 4 points May, whilst in stocks things were equally listless, even Catalinas having drifted down to "picholeo" dealing. Some B. Ayres Ports were done at 26.50, which shews an advance of a point, though the price is still susceptible of great improvement, holders of the stock calculating that at 35 it would still be good buying. A splendid prize has been towed into he harbour by the Cunard liner Samaria, ound from Valencia via Gibraltar, laden with fruit, for Liverpool. The prize in uestion is the German barque Schiffsverft, of Flensburg, 867 tons. She was when picked up on a voyage fron San Nicolas, River Plate, bound to Plymouth, with Indian corn. She is in a complete state of wreckage: her foremast, mizenmast, bowsprits, and jibboom gone-in fact nothing but the mizen lower mast remains. The Samaria fell in with the ill-fated vessel on last Sunday in latitude 47.15 North and longitude 8.38 west or 180 miles west of the Fastnet. When the captain of the Samaria sighted her he bore down upon her and discovered that she was a derelict drifting about the high seas. The chief officer and six men at once went on board of her and sounded the pumps, when they found there was no water in the well. A chronometer and sextant were discovered, and the clothes of the crew of the ill-fated ship were lying about in great disorder. The decks were smashed in several places, which was the only thing wrong with the hull of the ship. There was no sign of life on board save three cats and a pig. Hawsers were quickly passed to the Samaria, and the owage commenced, which required incessant watchfulness, great care and much attention on the part of those on board the Samaria. The towage proved a difficult and dangerous duty, as the hawsers snapped twice and new hawsers had to be supplied. The strain on them proved very evere at times, and when they parted he vessels went adrift. Again, if the amaria abandoned the wreck she would have left her to be a waif of the sea, drifting about the ocean, and at night time a perfect menace to steamships and sailing MARTIN. 
