At the meeting held in Prince George's Hall on 21st April, 1897, a Committee was appointed to consider various schemes proposed for the commemoration of the 60th anniversary of the accession to the throne of Her Majesty Queen Victoria. The Committee submitted its report to a

general meeting held on 6th May, 1897, and recommended the following:— 1.—A congratulatory telegram to the Queen, and a request to employers to give their employees a holiday. 2.—A free entertainment at the Circus

3.—Performance of the opera "H. M. S

4.—The erection of a Sailors' Home as permanent memento of the event, to be handed over to the Sailors' Home Committee on completion.

These proposals were adopted. The above Committee has been appointed to carry them into effect, and it now appeals to those who sympathise with the object for subscriptions to the fund required for the purpose.

The land for the proposed Sailors Home has been granted by Congress free of charge and for the erection and furnishing of the building it is estimated that a sum of about \$80,000 will be required. Statistics submitted to the Committee relative to the working of the present Home (the rent of which is \$300 per month) show that with a more suitable building, free of rent and properly equipped, the institution would be almost selfsupporting, so that, while it will be a lasting memento of an event which is unique in the history of the British Em-pire, it is not likely that there will be an increased call on the annual subcribers for its maintenance. Appended will be found a few particulars of the work done by the present Home.
