the rivers of the Apurimac and Desaguadero they are made by the Indians of long thick robes, being sufficiently strong to resist, for six months, the daily frosts of nocturnal ice and animals, they require, frequent repairs after that period; and for the want of which many soulless people, who are not removed at the end of each year, are replaced by a new one; it is across of the ground, on each bank of the river, by long wooden poles and in a similar manner as for the drying of bullock hides. The nerves of the bold traveler are, more or less, affected on crossing these bridges, from the unbalancing movement at each step, however slight it may be, and which gradually increases as he arrives at its center, then the patches, or rapids, wherever and there meet his eye, indicating in too forcible language the weakness of the structure over which he is passing and which in an instant might give way, and burn him into the river beneath.

The Indians of Peru, particularly those of the Ancient Capital, are frequently dragged from their families and homes, and compelled to serve in army; many of them on crossing the Apurimac bridge, on their way to a southern province, have been killed, the culprit on the "bridge of sighs," the agonies around them the last time they breathed their last sigh, and plunged into the river beneath them.

A regiment of infantry, composed of Indians, was passing this bridge in 1840, when a company of these passed in front of their ranks, and plunged into the depths of the stream; acted this nature are frequent among these troops, who, being taken by force to serve in the army, and treated by their officers as beasts of burden, prefer a voluntary and violent death to a life of misery and despair.
