Col. Roizala has been named to the command of the expedition.

Romero Flores at the head of 1000 men attacked the city of Cajamarca. The garrison defeated the Montenegrinos after a bloody struggle of 6 hours, during which 150 men were killed and 200 wounded.

Santiago de Chile 23rd.—The Arbitration Tribunal has not held session for some days. It is believed that the Tribunal will be abolished and that the settlement of war-claims will be left in the hands of the Chilean Government. Such is the opinion upheld by the foreign arbitrators.

M. José Ignacio Verga has been named Minister of the Interior, in place of M. Emilio Oriolgo Vara. Since yesterday the British Barque Martha Jackson has been kept in observation at Valparaiso, as she left Ayacucho without a bill of health.

Patagonia 23rd.—The German Minister is very reticent with regard to the object of his trip. To-morrow he leaves for Puerto Roca. Last night he was entertained by Mr. and Mrs. Bronted at a soirée, which ended in a dance.

Two vessels have arrived with full cargoes of wheat for the St. Sebastian mill.

The weather is magnificent. Montevideo 24th.—It is rumored that Brian, the Jefe de Policia, will resign.

Dr. Isaac de Tezanos is dying. No hope for him. The Navigation and Commercial treaty with Italy has been signed.

Carve has sent a vote to Government giving a detailed account of the negotiation for the port scheme in London. Telegrams from London yesterday report Unifrid at 49.
