The best friends of the sheepfarmers, and the would-be sheepfarmers, are those who tell them the plain, unvarnished truth. The exaggerated representations made, almost universally of sheepfarming, as a business, has been the bane of many, very many, and the bane of the business itself.

To 'tumble into sheepfarming,' however inexperienced the party might be was, and is still, generally repre sented as good fortune, 'par excel-

Sheepfarming is no exception to the law which governs all businesses. A fortuitous combination of circumstances may lead, and has led, to success and wealth in this as well as any other business. Some men may have greatness (or wealth) thrust upon them,' but in the long run men must earn their bread by the sweat of their brow, and the exercise of the higher faculties of the mind, in all avo-

It does not require 2 very lengthy or difficult calculation to arrive at the conclusion, that a long price paid for land, or a high rent, for the purpose of rearing on it a number of sheep, worth a few shillings each, \$20 or \$30, yielding a fleece worth, nett 8d., 10d., to 14d., is not a very brilliant business.

In this month 1863, I wrote in the Standard' to the effect, that either land must fall to the level of au inferior stock. or stock [sheep] must be reared on it of a quality and value commensurate with the price or rent of land; as 2½, 3, or 4 lbs. of 'starveling' wool per sheep, cannot possibly give an adequate return to the sheepfarmer, at the present rent and value of camps. Flockmasters have practically found this out, and they have sought to better themselves by 'cramming on' stock, and so destroying their camps and debilitating the sheep, and exposing themselves to 'epidemia,' that convenient blindfolding term, invented to 'salve over' the inevitable consequences of the sheepfarmers' own folly; in fact, they have been continually 'killing the goose, in the hope of getting all the golden eggs.'

Sheepfarming in this country can only henceforward be made profitable by judicious management of and outlay in the improvement of the sheep, and in providing them with sufficient food and feeding ground, by which a fleece of sound stapled wool, at least double the present average weight may be obtained.

A man can afford to pay the presen price for land if he has sheep to pu on it that yield him 6 or 7 lbs. of wool each, worth \$100 per ar.; or if he is prepared to take the steps to attain this yield, and thus necessitate a total change of system in the management of the flocks and the selection, maintenance, and use of the rams.

Sheepfarmers might congratulate themselves if a few such honest and practical writers as 'Pastor,' would more frequently address them through your columns. FARMER.
