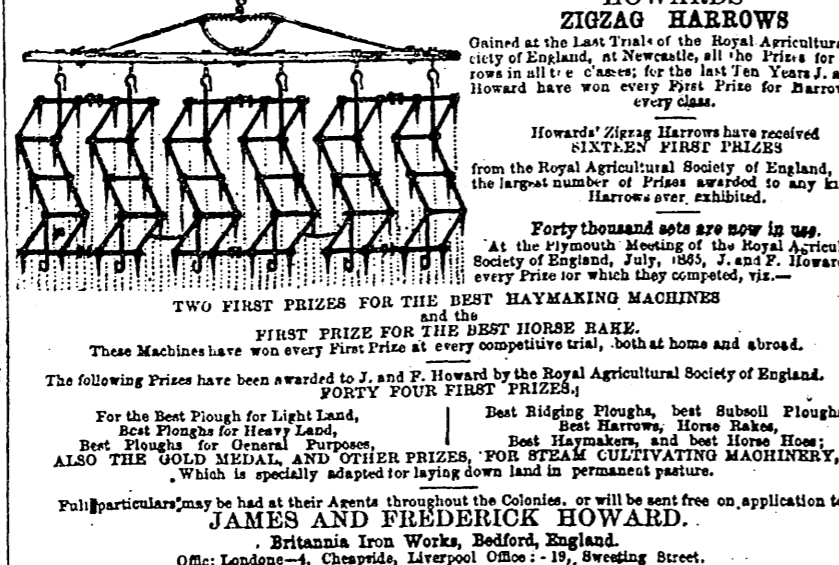


Illustration of a steamship, likely the 'La Plata' mentioned in the text.
