IMPORTANT FOR THE BANK

EXORBITANT FALSE EMISSION IN THE STATES. Philadelphia, Oct. 9th.

The Secretary of the Treasury on October 6th promulgated his official statement of the condition of the public debt of the United States on the 1st of the month.

During the month of September the debt has been reduced \$26,763,126 62c., this reduction having mainly been made by paying off the temporary loan certificates, the same course which was followed in making the large reduction during August.

The various items of the debt otherwise stand much as they did on September 1, excepting that several millions of the seven and three-tenths per cent. notes have been funded into 5-20 bonds.

The amount of money in the Treasury on October 1 was \$128,213,767 69c., a decrease of \$4,400,000 as compared with September 1.

Of this amount the gold is \$86,259,909 35c., and the paper \$41,953,858 24c., an increase as compared with September 1 of \$9,925,991 8c. in gold, but a decrease of \$14,343,891 22c. in paper.

THE LATE M. THOUVENEL.

Another of the statesmen who have played a conspicuous part in making European history in the present eventful epoch has passed away from the scene.

M. Thouvenel has just died at a comparatively early age, and just at the time when the policy which the last days of his official life were devoted to carrying out was beginning to bear fruit.

It was in November, 1818, that the deceased statesman was born at Verdun, and at the age of twenty-one he commenced his diplomatic career in the Foreign Department of the French Government.

He had previously travelled in the East, where he had acquired no inconsiderable knowledge, young as he then was, of the diplomatic interests and relations of the countries he visited.

Five years later, when he was about twenty-six years of age, he obtained his appointment as attaché to the French Embassy in Belgium, and the next year, 1845, he was promoted to be Secretary of the Legation at Athens.

When we review the career of this statesman we are struck by a singular coincidence. His official life began and his natural life terminated very early; they were as brief as they were active and important.

Another remarkable circumstance is the number of different Governments under which he served his country without a suspicion of undue versatility.
