Gold keeps still declining, and the market continues with a downward tendency. The bears' possession of the Bolsa, and are quite sanguine that for the end of the year the price of patacon will be under 22.

The specie market is in a most peculiarly critical state. The probabilities are that prices will still run down, no matter what steps the Government or Legislature may adopt.

The news from the interior to-day is of a most unfavorable nature, and in San Juan, although nothing new has occurred, there is the greatest alarm; the Rickard silver mines are barricaded, and guards mounted.

The new Argentine Bank of Rosario is at present actively canvassing subscriptions, and immediately the branch in this city will be opened.

It is difficult to define the state of the wool market. In the South Plaza about 15,000 arg sold at 60 to 65, and in the North Plaza not quite so much sold, and at lesser rates.

As far as we can learn the limits from Antwerp received by the packet do not allow the buyers to purchase even at the present low prices.

A very fine lot of wool was deposited to-day no higher price being obtainable than 65; the first part of this wool was sold in the market 15 days ago at 82. This shows the real fall in prices, no matter what the barragueros may say to the contrary, and the only relief to the market at present is the deposit stores. Mr. Frango finds fault with our stating that the process are insufficient to press the wool, as, although his barraca is almost full to the roof his

press is idle. We have been promised a table showing the relative prices paid in Antwerp and Havre, with those paid here. Most of the principal estancieros are now busy with the lighter-men, shipping their wool on their own account to the Havre market.

Messrs. C. W. Benn and Co. have chartered the Schleswig-Holstein brig Juliana, for Havre, bales and hides, current rates.
