LATEST FROM MONTEVIDEO.

(ELECTRIC TELEGRAPH.)

January 29, 1847. Seven lighters from Bucoo, with articles from the wreck of the Mozart: she is full of water.

MONTEVIDEO.

Monday, Jan. 28, 1867.

The sea-bathing season is in full force and the hotels are crowded with visitors from Buenos Ayres and elsewhere. Yesterday on arrival of the Arno and Villa del Salto most of the passengers flocked to the Oriental Hotel...

Not much importance was attached to this political news; some talked of the weather, others of their quintas, and the rest of hides and tallow. The market reports from Europe are rather discouraging: hides down, and wool apathetic...

The mails from Rio brought to-day two letters from the Standard correspondent which Mr. Spruick promptly forwarded: they contained important intelligence. The Telegraph office and Club were crowded yesterday; everybody anxious to learn the European news.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF DR. MATEO LUQUE. Dr. Matthew Luque, the subject of this memoir, who is now figuring so conspicuously in the political affairs of this Republic, was born in Cordova, and although educated in the ancient University of that city, which had hitherto only given to the world lawyers and theologians, is by profession a physician...

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Meanwhile the political aspect of affairs had greatly changed. Rosas was now some ten months gone to South America, and General Urquiza driven from Buenos Ayres. A Congress was convened in Santa Fé, Cordova had to send her representatives, and amongst them we find Dr. Luque. It were difficult to account for his election; possibly the young men of Cordova felt sympathy for the man who had undergone so much, and who had given proofs of the most decided talent, for in no place more than Cordova does real genuine talent command greater admiration and respect.

Now a new life opened for Dr. Luque, and filled his brain with delusive visions. He was unprepared for the change. His country, for the first time in his life, crossed his path, and his whole mind and sentiments were disturbed. A stranger to the political questions of the day, and to the close studies of social economy, he betrayed weakness, and acknowledged his incapacity for his present position; any one else would have quietly resigned, but the doctor was determined to prove his idiosyncrasy. "I resign," says he, "and if you insist on my serving I shall poison myself," speaking as if
