PROGRESS OF BRAZIL.

M. Le Long has just written a very interesting article, which appears in the 'Economiste Francaise,' on the Empire of Brazil, and its Social and Economic Advancement. We translate the following extracts:— With an extension four times that of France, a soil extraordinarily fertile, and, thanks to the Cordilleras, whose great chains, with their ramifications, traverse the interior of the country from north to south, Brazil, as respects the majority of its provinces, is able to reward the toil of the husbandman with the products of the temperate climates, as well as of those of the torrid zone.

Some days since, a journal published a correspondence representing a rising of the whole black population of Brazil as inevitable. Para was designated as one of the principal centres of this movement, and very probably the correspondent of the Parisian paper in which the statement was made was ignorant of the fact that this province, with a population of half a million inhabitants, does not contain more than 10,000 slaves!
