Every one seems to think that the market must go up, and the greatest proof of the peculiar speculation that is going on, is that of the 331,000 sold, only 10,000 were for cash. Mercants, as a rule, keep away from the market, owing to the apprehension of bad news from Europe; but unless we receive advices of war having broken out, there can be little doubt of the further rise in prices. There was a very thin attendance on 'Change to-day, and nothing much doing in any branch of business. Exchange rates at 4 1/2, no bills having been passed at a higher rate to-day; but very little as yet done.

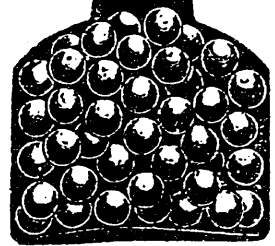
