Tuesday evening. A telegram has just been received by the Telegrafo Maritimo, that the Brazilian fleet went to Humaita and found the Paraguayans had lost all their ammunition by the great flood. Two years ago these boats would have foundered, but public credulity has long since been exhausted in this Paraguayan war.

An alarming rumor is current respecting the loss of a Spanish vessel with 140 emigrants; a boat has been picked up at Maldonado, relating the loss of the vessel and every soul on board. It is this disaster is confirmed, as seems but too likely, it will be proper to urge on Government the necessity of at once restoring the light to Lobos Island, instead of its present dangerous locality at Maldonado. What are the interests of the seal-fishers, compared with the sacrifice of 140 human beings?

The news from Europe, per San Jose, is most important and has been already sent up by telegram. The Arno is expected to-morrow.

On Saturday and Sunday we had four Brazilian transports, the San Jose, Itapicuru, Alice, and Silva, with some 1200 men from Rio and Santa Catalina. Poor fellows! so much food for powder and pestilence in Paraguay.

Advices from Rio mention the arrival of the Narcissus on the 26th and Magicienne on the 28th ult. The Narcissus left Rio on the 2nd inst., supposed for the River Plate. They are building another iron clad, to be called the Sta Catalina, in the Rio Arsenal. To-day is the 2nd anniversary of the great naval battle of Riachuelo.

The extraordinary occurrences with Dr. Gounouillou and Tezanos are still a subject of general conversation. The Dr., it is said, was in B. Ayres, when Gen. Flores sent him word that "ali was right, to come down," as if accepting his offer of \$250,000: in the defence entered at the Criminal Court it seems the prisoner alleges he offered the money for the good of the State, and not to the General. The whole affair is a strange 'embroglio.' Tezanos was released after a few hours detention: the Tribuna states that Flores charged him with having deserted from the Colorado army in 1864, and adds that, on being arrested, he gave up a dagger which he wore under his coat. The same evening D. Agustin Susviela was also summarily arrested.

The cholera has not wholly disappeared on Saturday, D. Antonio Machado died after 10 hours illness, and an Italian artisan in the hospital. The Italian Minister procured the release of 5 burglars supposed to be recently arrived from Naples, and shipped them at once back to Genoa.

M. Liez Bedari, who caused such a furore about preserved beef, leaves in the French packet to get up a company in Paris.

M. Gottschalk the pianist, gives his first performance to-night at the Philharmonic Hall.

The recent interruption to the Telegraph wires was caused by some bullock-carts knocking down about 500 yards of posts and wires near Canelones: it seems Mr. Oldham has caused one of the 'troperos' to be put in prison.

LATEST FROM BRAZIL. Rio Janeiro, June 4, 1867.

I last wrote you by the transport Alice on 29th ult., but the Post Office Authorities here having advertised a mail on the 3rd inst. by the transport S. José, I sent to your Montevideo Agents the Diario do Rio of the 1st and 2nd inst. and the Diario Oficial of this latter date, as in them would be found the latest advices from Europe and the United States as well as the new Custom House Regulations in Rio for the collection of duties on 'carne seca.' The S. José however has been detained and only leaves to-day, therefore it is very probable that the bearer may arrive first at Montevideo, and even get there before the Arno, so I send you enclosed the latest telegrams from Europe and the U. States and under separate cover I forward to your Montevideo, Agents the European Times of the 9th ult.

The Narcissus arrived here from the River Plate on the afternoon of the 28th ult. The Arno arrived here last evening, but the mails were only delivered this morning.

On the 28th His Majesty the Emperor, accompanied by his staff, went to the Island of Cobras and there laid the keel of another monitor, on the same stocks from which the monitor Para was launched the other day. The vessel now in construction is to be named the Santa Catharina.

Constitution says:—The husband of the Princess, heir presumptive to the Crown, shall have no part in the Government, and shall only have the title of Emperor after the Empress, his consort, shall have had a son or daughter.

The reply on the part of the Senate, to the Imperial Speech is considered to be in high opposition to the present Cabinet but as this body is not considered to represent the political ideas of the people and as the Ministry counts as yet upon a majority in the Chamber of Deputies, this fact alone is not likely to cause a change in the Imperial Cabinet. The majority however in the Chamber of Deputies has shown itself very feeble so far, and has not been disposed to stand by the Ministers in all the questions raised.

The Diario Oficial of the 28th contradicts the statements of the Siglo of Montevideo relative to a question having arisen about the frontier line of Brazil and Uruguay, and to which I informed you in my last the Diario do Rio had alluded.

The Steeple-chase announced by the Club Jacome for the 30th ult., came off with due eclat on that day in the presence of the Imperial family and a very large assemblage of spectators. There were four races and three horses ran in each. The riders were all attired in true jockey style and in tasteful colours. The horses were all good-looking animals and in first-rate condition, but there is room for great improvement in the equestrian abilities of the members of the club, for in each race one or more horses ran away with their riders, and lucky was the jockey who escaped without a fall. As the winner of the last race, rode up to the presence of the Imperial family and attempted to make one of his best and most loyal bows his impolite horse threw him amid shouts of laughter on the part of the lookers on.

Let me call your special attention to a leader in the Diario do Rio, which I sent you by the S. José, commenting on the Relatorio of the Minister of Finance; a second article, which I now enclose, has since been published and is likewise worthy of perusal.

THE WAR IN THE NORTH. EXTRAORDINARY FLOODS. EVACUATION OF CUROZU.

On 29th, May the river Paraguay had so far overflowed its banks that it was found impossible for the Brazilians any longer to hold their own in Curuzu. They were therefore ordered by the Marques de Caxias to embark for Itapiru, but in the front of so formidable a battery manned by a most wary and watchful enemy, this was not found such an easy matter, and after a long conference with the Admiral, Porto Alegre determined to effect it under cover of the fleet; that is, he was to clear out bag and baggage while the fleet kept the enemy engaged with a feigned attack on the fort. The boat's approach the fight in the following order:—Iron-clads, Brazil, Lima Barros, Silvada, Balda, Barros, Tamandaré, Marris, Barros, Colombe, Herval and Cabral. Gunboats Mage, Paranaíba, Forte de Coimbra and Pedro Alfonso, with the 'chatas' and Cuevas in close attendance. The Brazil carried the Admiral's pennant, and was conspicuous for the active part she took in the day's proceedings.

The land guns also fired a few charges by way of a parting salute. The enemies at first answered slowly and at intervals, but were soon extinguished by the heavy shower of shot and shell from the monitors. It has been said that the fleet attempted to pass up, but this is a most groundless falsehood, as the least movement of the kind must necessarily have betrayed Porto Alegre, and jeopardized its entire command; and the vigor of the assault, in which the allies expended over three thousand shells, is the only palliation for such an assertion.

At evening the cavalry having been safely shipped without accident, and only a few companies of foot left to guard the guns, the fleet again fell back to its morning's moorings, without having sustained any injuries, and with only the loss of 15 men wounded. Next morning when the Paraguayans found out how they had been fooled they were furious, and for three muffled hours they blazed away on the devoted little band, who though unaided by the squadron and almost drowned out by the rising water, still nobly held their own against all odds. At length the fire ceased, having within those three hours burst more than 1200 shells, and leaving sixteen of the garrison wounded. To effect this it is said the Paraguayans had raised new batteries.

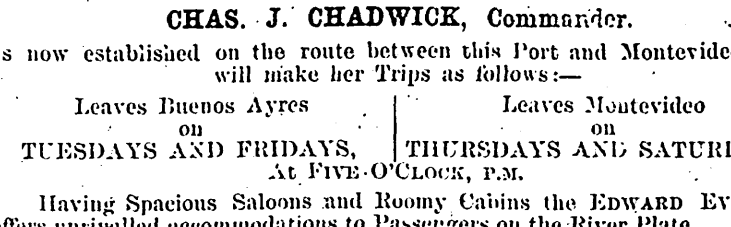
