Montevideo, Jan. 24. The new Brazilian Minister, Señor Amaral, will be officially received to-day. The carriages for the Union Tramway are being landed. Cholera decidedly better.

The past fortnight has been a most afflicting period for us all, cholera has swept over the land with a severity unexampled since its visitation in Europe in 1832.

THE PROCLAMATION OF PATRICIO RODRIGUEZ.

The proclamation of Patricio Rodriguez, published on his leaving Rosario, is open rebellion against the National Government. This rebel leader, it is rumored, has joined with an Indian chief, and it is thought that he will probably attack San Nicolas.

As an instance of the value of land in the suburbs, and what it gives when properly tilled, we may state that one of the quinteros of the Miguensquitas, on the Calle Larga, has a small plot of ground, twenty yards by fifty, which he plants always with carrots; that small piece of ground yields \$3,000 mpc. per annum.

The great and unceasing charities of the Masons during the present afflicting season has attracted much attention, and many parties who, for religious or other motives, are opposed to these secret societies, have come forward to subscribe their mite towards helping the Masons in their noble charities.

The whitewashing decree has completely changed the aspect of our streets; old walls and tumble-down houses are now nicely whitewashed. The Custom-house requires the brush; it looks very dirty, and was once the whitest building in the city.

The Rosa steamer came in yesterday from Montevideo with mails and passengers. We have received papers to the 22d, and publish below all the news at hand.

It is presumed in high political circles that President Mitre will not accept the resignations sent in by two of his Ministers, and among the current on this is the following, that it has been hinted to Dr. Velez Sarsfield that the President was anxious to entrust him with the formation of a new Cabinet, under certain restrictions as to its personnel, which, however, this eminent statesman refused to comply with; and the negotiations, therefore, fell to the ground.

The thermometer in town has long since passed cocktail degree, and, after hovering about revolution heat, is increasing to universal melting point, when it is hoped all parties will quietly amalgamate.

SANTA FE REVOLUTION.

As your old correspondent does not consider that he is safe as long as Mr. Paz governs the town, he is still unable, I should imagine, to continue his letters to the "Standard," from the impossibility of going out and witnessing the events of each day, and gathering up data to place before your readers.

The events of the last few days are devoid of stirring interest. Further than the fact of the intervention, we are in complete ignorance of what are to be the tactics of the National troops.

Mr. Cabal sent up word to Colonel Nelson not to fight, that it was useless, I suppose, he meant, Nelson, on receiving the letter, swore that nothing could keep him from fighting.

I do not think the nature of this revolution is at all understood in Buenos Ayres. The only people known in it are Rodriguez, Nelson and Paz; the first, a caudillo of 'prestige' amongst the gauchos, a man who enjoys a very excellent reputation, notwithstanding.

The election for the new members of the Municipality took place yesterday. Six of the members go out by rotation and three have resigned. There will therefore be nine to replace.

We ourselves and our contemporaries have been premature in announcing the departure of Mr. Drabble. He leaves for England with his family in the packet at the end of March.

Messrs. Matti and Piera despatch the small steamer Beaulieu for Montevideo this afternoon, with correspondence only.

Let a battalion of National troops enter Rosario, and it will soon be seen how popular the movement is!

MEANDERINGS IN SOUTH AMERICA.

Fray Bentos is said to have derived its name, "from an old friar Bentos, who used to pass the greater part of his time in wandering through the woods here."

The town of Fray Bentos was, by a decree of the Buenos Ayres Government, named "Villa Independencia," and is still entitled so in official documents.

The first important settlement at Fray Bentos was in 1857, when a company, composed of Messrs. Hughes, Brothers, of Montevideo, Messrs. James and Lewis, George Hodgskin, and Erskine brothers, purchased an estate here, lying in the direction between the rivers Uruguay and Negro.
