#### ARGENTINE REPUBLIC. CONSUL HUTCHINSON'S REPORT.

[CONTNUATON.]

The Argentine Custom House Law, which is a national one, and is in some degree modified by a new statute every year, may be considered as interesting chiefly to exporters and importers. The general average of its du-

ties is 15 per cent. for imports and 5 per cent. for exports; but these are frequently increased by a chapter for additional duties, consequent on the necessity for levying war supplies. As an illustration of this, I may here give an extract from the Ministers'- Report Custom-house.


