A NEW PLANET. Detroit, August 16, 1868. Professor Watson, of the Detroit Observatory, furnishes the following report:— I have the pleasure to announce the discovery of a new minor planet which I made last night. It shines like a star of the tenth magnitude, and at twilight this morning was situated as follows:—Right ascension, 358 degrees and 24 minutes; declension, zero degrees and 48 minutes south. Its apparent motion is now west and north 34 seconds of time in the right ascension, and 4 minutes of time arc in declension.
