The Poitou arrived this morning, having left Rio on the 9th inst.

In 1861 he was appointed to the command of the Spanish contingent of the force sent to Mexico by France, England and Spain.

The Carlists declined with the death of Zumalacaregui, June 25, 1835, and declined still further when Espartero, in 1836,

But another revolutionary movement broke out in the same year, when the Cortes passed a new "annunciamento" law.

In March, 1863, Marshal O'Donnell and his Cabinet resigned, since which period the Ministry has been changed entirely or partly several times.

On the night of January 9, a conspiracy was discovered among the troops at Valencia, which gradually extended during the next few days to other troops in the southwestern provinces.

Antoine Marie Philippe Louis d'Orleans, Duke of Montpensier, is the favorite of those among the Spanish revolutionists who desire the preservation of a monarchy.

A local insurrection broke out in Catalonia in April, 1867, which was suppressed and a number of the insurgents were captured.

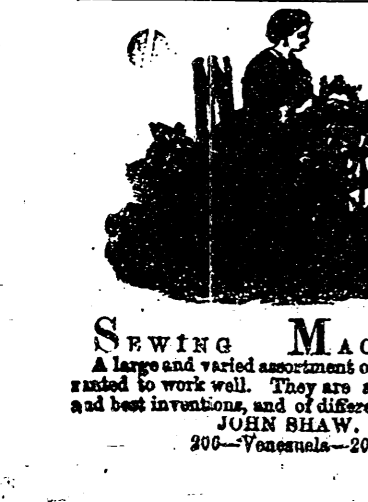

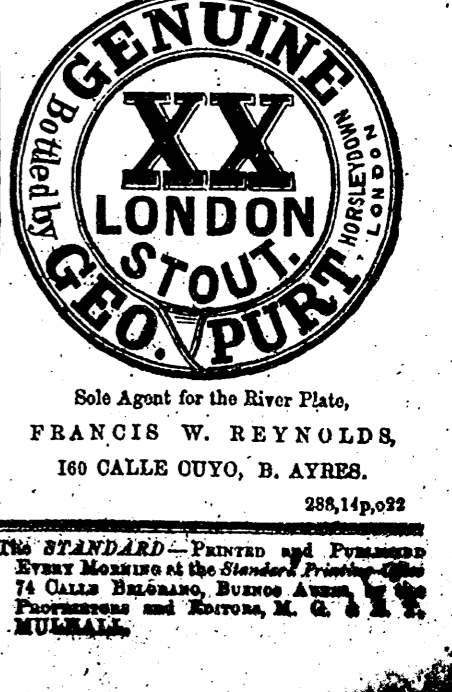
