No: a Yankee would show the world that he was more a man than a woman; he would bewail less and act more.

Self-preservation is a law that requires to murder the everything relating to murder the Government would appear to be powerless. Few murderers are arrested and none are executed nor adequately punished. Capital punishment is not abolished by law, but would appear to be so by effeminate judges.

As the law at present stands, the Executive branch of the Government can do nothing more than place criminals in the hands of the judicial branch: this branch, being independent of the other two branches which form the Government, will not execute, or rather pronounce sentence of execution against the most bloodthirsty cutthroat: it has not the means at command of awarding any other adequate punishment. Hence crime is daily on the increase.

The province of Buenos Ayres can boast of over fifty volumes of statute laws and decrees, independently of two codes, one of which is now national as well as provincial, and two more in course of progress, which will shortly be in full force.

There is a wonderful desire for law-making on the part of the legislators, but a law is scarcely enacted when it is forgotten by the judges, by the bar, and by the people.

Whatever shadow of law there may be in the city, the rural districts are ruled, not only without reference to any of the written laws, but very frequently in direct opposition to them.

Murder, according to the statute law, is a crime of a serious nature; but, according to the common law in usage, it is a crime of such little import that the authorities will scarcely arrest you for such a paltry offence.

Perhaps, for their own lives, seeing that most of the murderers who have been imprisoned are at large in a few months, free, and no doubt willing, to renew a like offence.

A short time since, two men were arrested at Las Flores for the murder of a Frenchman; the circumstantial evidence was so strong against them that every person who heard the details was convinced of their guilt.

They were seen going in the direction of the spot where the man was found murdered, a few moments afterwards cries of help and moans were heard, and shortly after these died away two men were seen gallop at a furious rate from the direction wherein the man was found, carrying off with them a leading horse, saddled. The closing of the Maná and Navia Banks in Montevideo to day was the absorbing topic of the day. Some could discover the reason or motives for such a line of conduct, but it was supposed that the banks had some difficulty with the new committee. This extraordinary news from Montevideo it was thought would have an injurious effect on the bond market, and there was an effort made to bear the market, but it failed signally; prices not only were fully maintained, but rose 1/2 for cash, and the market closed extremely firm.

The speculation in the market was much safer to day respecting the movements for the middle of the month, which fall due to-morrow. The bulls justified in the liquidation-rumor that all bonds falling due would be taken up "a crédito," the amount is not to say large, but if sellers are called on to deliver, a further rise in prices may be looked for.

Sr. Paranhos will leave to-morrow for Paraguay. His speedy departure augurs well: a new Provisional Government will be at once named, and a strong force despatched to Pirabete to rescue the families from the power of Lopez. The Argentine and Oriental Ministers Plenipotentiary to meet Sr. Paranhos in Asuncion.

The continuance of quarantine in Montevideo is regarded as a sort of imposition on the public. The health of Buenos Ayres was never better; all the towns along the river are represented as extremely healthy, no cholera whatever, and yet in the continent quarantine continues to be maintained. The French packet to-day takes down a mail bag for Montevideo, but it is impossible to say whether it will be delivered or not, owing to the scandalous port regulations of Montevideo.

Some of the shareholders of the Gas Company are anxious to know why the regular annual meeting has not been convened, and what about the dividend. The shares are somewhat firmer and may be quoted at 60 premium.

In the North Wool Plaza to-day the most important sale was effected by Sr. Martin, 1,500 ar at 63. Owing to the closing of the Maná and Navia Bank at Montevideo, the Export of Salted Hides from this country has also been comparatively insignificant, viz, 24,374 cwt., or about 50,000 hides against nearly three times that quantity in 1867. Were this all, it would sufficiently show that there was no reason for the advance in prices which for some time was secured. But in addition, the Continental Ports have been freely supplied with Hides, and their Stocks are at present very large. It is satisfactory to find that under these circumstances, Tanners have been sparing in their purchases, the sales of South American Salted Hides being less by 173,317, or nearly one-fourth, than they were in the previous year. It is policy is adhered to with sufficient pertinacity, the equilibrium between the supply and demand of Heavy Foreign Butts will be restored, and manufacturers will at length be likely to obtain more remunerative prices for their Leather than of late years.

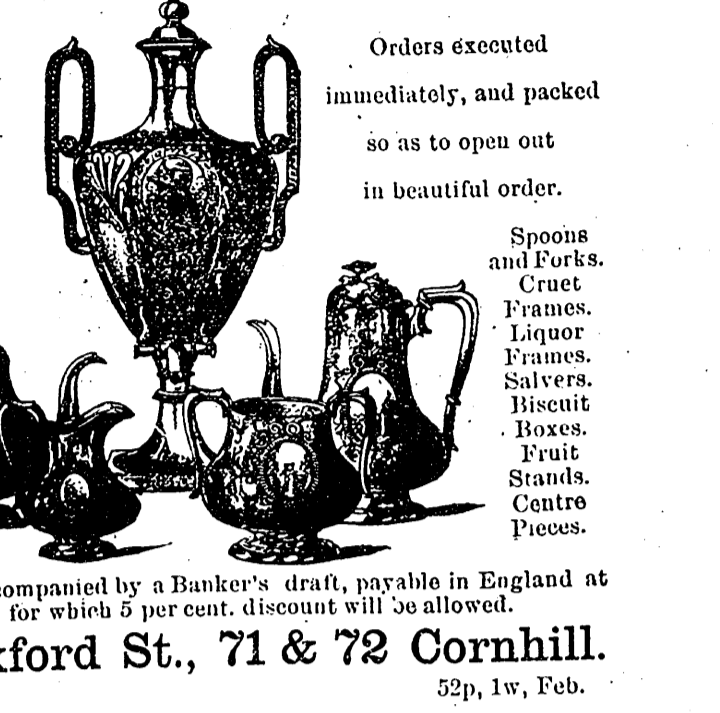

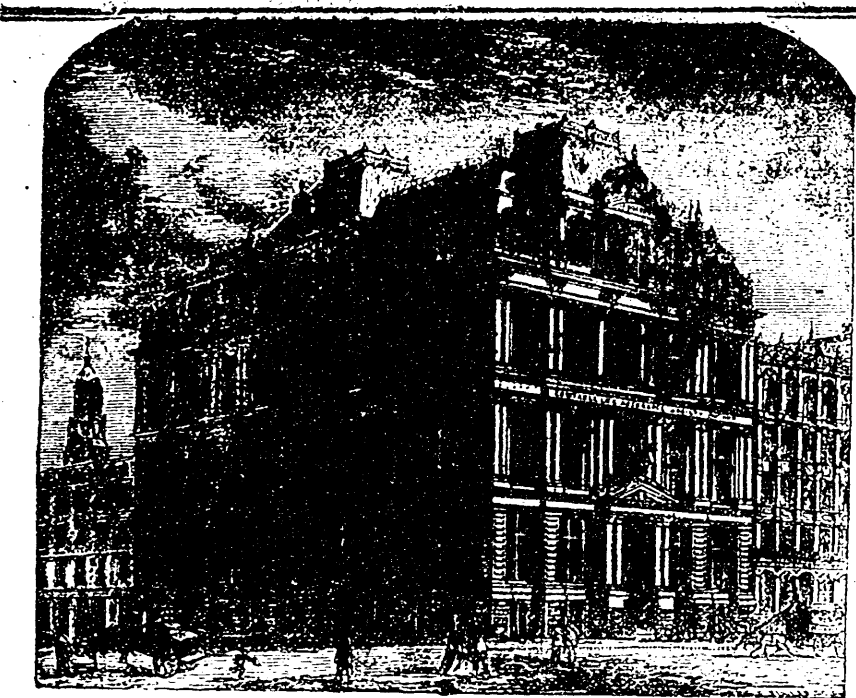
