We are glad to hear that the members of the Philharmonic Society have begun their weekly reunions for the coming winter season at the Coliseum. The second rehearsal for the first concert will take place to-morrow—Monday—night at eight o'clock precisely, when it is to be hoped that the attendance on the part of the active members will be as numerous as usual.

As the 3.40 p.m. train of the Boca, Barracas, and Ensenada Railway was coming out of the Boca branch line on Friday, the engine ran off the line causing a complete stoppage of traffic for the rest of the day. HALF-YEARLY MEETING. The usual half-yearly meeting of this association was held on the evening of the 9th inst., in the rooms of the British Library.

In the unavoidable absence of the President, The Vice-President, Mr. Soden, was called upon to take the chair. After explaining the object of the meeting, he requested the secretary to read the following HALF-YEARLY REPORT.

28th Feb., 1869. Your committee, in laying before you the usual half-yearly report of the society, have much pleasure in congratulating you upon the satisfactory state of its affairs. They limit themselves to calling your attention to the principal subjects of interest that have occurred during the past six months. You will observe from the subjoined statement that on the 31st August last the number of members embodied in the society consisted of 28 holding 186 shares, while at present there are 34 holding 242 shares, showing an increase of 6 members and 56 shares. NEW ZEALAND.

THE MASSACRE AT POVERTY BAY. Advice have come to hand this morning from New Zealand, with newspapers, the latest date of which is December 5. The "Wangauiti Times," of November 14, gives the following particulars of the attack upon the Wereroa redoubt:—

The Wereroa redoubt, which has been held for the last fortnight by about 40 of the 1st class militia, was attacked under the following circumstances:—On Thursday evening, Captain Wilmot Powell had his men, or rather boys, out at drill in front of the redoubt, when a volley was fired at them by the Hau-haus from the opposite side of a gully, but without doing any mischief. They immediately retired into the redoubt, pulled up the drawbridge, and stood every man to his post. The Hau-haus crossed the gully, and ascended the slope leading to the redoubt, firing and cheering each other on the attack. Our boys returned the fire, and in a spirited manner kept it up from half-past four till half-past nine at night. Two Hau-haus were shot dead, and dragged into the bush by their comrades. The number of killed and wounded could not be ascertained, but yesterday morning pools of blood were discovered in several places where the Hau-haus fought. There were no casualties on our side, but many narrow escapes. The firing was kept up with great spirit upon both sides during these five hours.
