On the 28th ult. Don Lorenzo Martinez, a much esteemed citizen of Cordoba, died in that city. The Governor of Cordoba has returned to the city, having made a tour of inspection through that province.

All the trains to Belgrano on Sunday were crowded to excess, and the punctuality with which they kept their time elicited very general satisfaction. The Star and Garter of South America, Watson's popular establishment, was the scene of unwonted animation, having been invaded from an early hour by numerous parties from town, most of whom only returned by the last train.

THE ADDRESS OF NELLIE GRANT.

From the Washington Chron. 12 Dec. 31. The following is the address of Miss Nellie Grant after being crowned Queen at the party given at the residence of the Italian Minister, Chevalier Marcel Cerruti, on Monday evening last:

My beloved subjects:—I feel greatly rejoiced to find myself on this happy occasion surrounded by my faithful subjects. I assume the crown and title of "Nellie the First," and I promise to reign over you inspired always with feelings of affection and justice. I begin my administration by an act of generosity and benevolence. I have ordered my Prime Minister to prepare for you many prizes in a lottery which I devote for you. Each of you may approach my throne, and I will confer upon you a number corresponding to a prize.

Some 50,000,000,000 worth of goods had been taken off the market, which gave prices an additional impetus, and about half-past three o'clock in the afternoon the approach in the liquidation room was such that it was almost impossible to ascertain the exact cash price, but it ranged about 573, buyers, 55 sellers, and the general feeling is, that as yet prices have not touched their highest.

The closest observers of the market view with some anxiety the great rise in prices, as they are fully aware that no combination of brokers could in the present state of the market maintain such a rise. Some attribute the rise to a general disposition to carry the stock until after the amortisation, but the most general impression is that bouds are getting into the hands of the public, and fast escaping from the limited circle which hitherto controlled them.

Exchange ruled firm to day at 498; about £100,000 sterling passed. It was generally said on "Change" that the English Bank had drawn for a large amount.

The sale of Messrs. Mallmann's fine estancia, in the Banda Oriental, was announced to-day, and considered by many as a sign of the times. This sale has attracted immense notice. The estancia contains six suertes of the very best land in the Banda Oriental; a magnificent azotea house, with a fine quinta; 20 puestas, all brick; 50,000 fine merino sheep, about 500 head of horned cattle, several tropillas of horses and mares,—in fact, the estancia precisely as it stands,—for the round sum of seventy-three thousand patucos. Buyer, Sr. Demarbi, the well known druggist, of Buenos Ayres. The place was valued a few months ago at 193,000 patucos. The estancia house alone cost 20,000 patucos. No sale for years has attracted so much notice.
