demand for gold for export is already subsiding.

An advance in the Bank rate of discount, though hindered at in some quarters yesterday, had been generally regarded as improbable, and consequently the announcement of the alteration led at once to a pressure of sales of the more speculative securities, the result being in some instances a further considerable reduction in prices.

The demand to-day at the Bank discount office was to a fair extent, but not pressing. The supply of money in the general market being limited, the rates at once followed the movement at the Bank of England, 4 1/2 per cent being required for good three months' bills.

The discount establishments have raised their terms for money at call from 3 to 3 1/2 per cent, at 7 days notice from 3 1/4 to 3 1/2, and 14 days notice from 3 1/4 to 4. The joint stock banks now allow 1 1/2 per cent. for money on deposit, instead of 1 1/4.
