THE HANDBOOK. (From the River Plate Mail.) We have gone through this elaborate compilation with great interest, and certainly whoever desire to make themselves acquainted with Argentine history, whether ancient or modern, have only to study this admirable guide.

Its contents are divided into three sections, (A, B, and C), the total comprising upwards of 500 pages of closely printed matter, arranged for easy reference, and the amount of information collected is something wonderful.

It could only have been accomplished by great labour and at a heavy cost, and we trust the public spirit evinced by Messrs Mulhall will be amply rewarded.

To those who contemplate a visit to the River Plate or a settlement in Argentine territory the details given in this Handbook are invaluable, and to the general reader the subjects treated of are divested of that dryness which generally appertains to such publications.

The only thing that appears to be wanting so far is a good map, as an index or key to the localities described, but it will probably be issued with the second volume, which it appears will be published in a few months at the moderate cost of 10s. a volume.

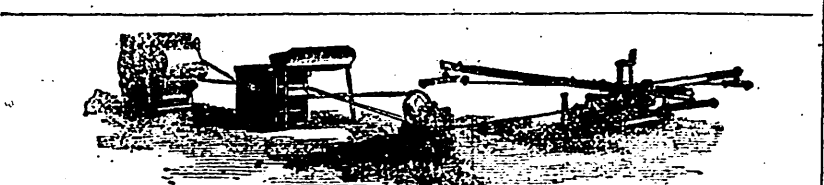
