THE LATE APPALING CASE OF MURDER.

To the Editors of the 'Standard,'
Gentlemen,—
It becomes my painful duty to put you in possession of the facts of a murder committed in this neighborhood, the revolting details of which can hardly be paralleled in the annals of crime.

I live in a district known as the Cañada Romero, about a league and a half from the town of the Capilla del Señor. On last Tuesday, the 3rd inst., I sent my young brother-in-law, Owen Keegan, aged 13 years, to the Capilla to purchase some trilling matters, my wife being confined two days before the murder. On his way thither he met with or was overtaken by the murderer or murderers, who mangled his throat in a manner too horrible to describe, besides inflicting at least twenty other wounds on his body and face.

At about half past four in the evening one of the Alcalde's sons came to me saying his father wished to see me but for what purpose he could not tell me. I started at once for the Alcalde's house, and on my arrival you may imagine my surprise and horror on learning that the boy was killed. On further inquiry he informed me that he found the body at about half past twelve o'clock, just ten minutes after his departure from my house, when I asked him why he did not send me word immediately, he answered that he did not know who it was. This statement I emphatically and unhesitatingly pronounced to be untrue, for the boy having been born and reared in the neighbourhood and within a short distance of the Alcalde's house, he was well known to all the neighbours and even mutilated as the corpse was it was easily identified by every one that saw it. On remarking, if you knew not the dead boy, you and your sons could not mistake the horse branded, as it was with my mark. To this he made no reply.

It appears to me that the local authorities were very remiss in this instance. The Alcalde sent word to the Justice of Peace, who sent the police cart and caused the body to be removed to the Capilla; whereas, if notice was sent to me before removing the body and search for the murderer at once made, he would now, in all probability, be in custody, or, at least, some clue as to his whereabouts might be obtained. But now he has had ample time to clear out, and will, doubtless, ultimately baffle pursuit.

At the place where the murder was committed there are evident marks of a severe struggle having taken place, also the track where the poor boy was dragged by a lasso from the road to a bare place close by, and there the murderer accomplished his ferocious purpose. Now, I ask, gentlemen, could a life and death struggle take place unnoticed in the midst of a populous neighbourhood? We all know what piercing shrieks a dying victim will utter. Did that active boy, aged 13 years, make no resistance or attract no attention by his screams of agony? Or was he overpowered, his throat frightfully lacerated, and his body and face gashed in a manner sickening to behold, was all this done with such lightning rapidity within fifteen hundred yards of two houses, that no one saw or heard it?

It is not known who perpetrated the appalling deed, or was it a neighboring vagabond. Was the motive plunder? A miserable twenty paper dollars was all the booty that could be found on the murdered boy. Was the fact of his being without father or mother no protection to him? Or did his youth, his innocence, his invariably unoffending demeanour towards every one, who the rage of the assassin? The more we reflect upon it, the more enormous does this frightful tragedy appear.

It would seem that the fiend who perpetrated it must have had all his tiger-like propensities excited to the highest pitch, for, not content with mangling the poor victim's throat, he gashed and stabbed until very weariness must have compelled him to desist. Now it remains to be seen what steps those entrusted with the commission of the peace will take in the matter. I suppose the Executive here would scorn to follow the example of the British Government by offering a reward for the apprehension of the murderer. No, there are too many decayed generals in petro boots, that must be provided for first.

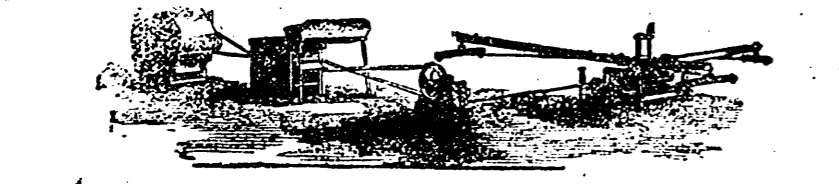
