AMATEUR BRITISH THEATRICALS.

THE performances on Wednesday night were a decided success, and the attendance comprised almost the whole English-speaking community of our city. The arrangements were in every respect admirable.

LATEST FROM MONTEVIDEO.

GREAT NEWS ABOUT THE BANKS. NO REVOLUTION.

August 18, 1869. Yesterday it was freely rumored that the Government and Baron Maua had at last come to terms; the evening paper also published the news, and there was joy throughout the town.

Rumors of another revolution have been rife here for the last few days, but we are happy to say that they are without foundation. The Government is taking some active measures, but not motivated by the fears of a revolution.

The weather is very severe, and the queen city of the Plata is in tears today, such rain; yet the steamer goes up to Buenos Ayres, and Mr. Simpson of the Boca railway and others insist on going in her.

The Spanish population here is busy getting up a protest in connection with a protest of the Spaniards in Paysandu, about the Regency in Spain.

Some small excitement was caused in the suburbs today by the Government stopping all bullock carts on the Agraciada road, the drivers were furious and the soldiers inexorable.

The memorable battle of Yatay was duly celebrated here on the 16th inst by the Chief of police and other dignitaries, they ought to read Col. Thompson's description of this battle.

The Government has yielded to the pressure and made Carralbo a Brigadier General. All sensible foreigners condemn this act, in fact it is difficult to defend it.

MARRIAGE BETWEEN CATHOLICS AND NON-CATHOLICS.

We publish a translation of an important note addressed by the Minister of Worship to the Bishop of Cuyo in reply to the Bishop's application for leave to proceed to Rome to attend the General Council.

The President directs me to inform Your Lordship that he has no objection to offer to your journey, and that he also authorizes you to leave in charge of your Diocese the Provisor and Vicar Dr. D. Braulio Laspiur.

I omit entering here into explanations having already fully given them to Your Lordship in the late official interview held between us. It is in the interest of Religion as well as of the State that the foreigners who flock to our shores, and who belong to dissenting creeds, may find every facility for contracting matrimony.

Our Constitution, the rights and guarantees thereby assured to all, are formed with the view that every one, whosoever he may come from, and whatever be his origin or creed, may meet on Argentine soil with a new mother country.

In conclusion, I beg to express my best wishes for your Lordship's happy voyage; at the same time I trust that your Lordship, penetrated with the views of the Government, will turn to account your residence in Rome, and your direct intercourse with the Holy See, so as to return invested with all the powers that will enable you to attend to the social want to which I have had the honor to call your Lordship's attention.

EDITOR'S TABLE.

Francisco Solano Lopez is a very stout man, about 45 years of age. He is short, but has a commanding presence. In England he would be called darkish, being about the colour of Spaniards generally, with black hair; his hands and feet are very small.

He is extremely fond of Mrs Lynch's children, but not of his other ones, of whom he has a number by different women. He entertains friendly feelings for no one, as he has shot almost all those who have been most favored by himself, and who have been years his only companions.

He is a great smoker, and lover of the table; he eats enormously; after dinner, when in a good humour, he occasionally sings a short song. He has a large stock of good claret, of which he is very fond, and which no one at his table used to drink but himself—not even Mrs Lynch or the Bishop; people dining with him were served with an inferior class of wine.

Lopez is a good speaker, especially in the kind of oratory likely to inspire his troops with confidence in himself and themselves, and with contempt for the enemy. He rarely himself did or said anything to disgust people, giving his orders for these things to General Resquin. He would allow no one to initiate a joke in his presence, though fond of making one himself; he is a great stickler for his dignity, and used to make even his brothers call him "Your Excellency."

He never feels the loss of his best officers and men, except as having so many men less to fight with, but he is particularly careful that the enemy should not know where he was, for which purpose he abolished the brass helmets of his guard and also its banners, and hid the guard behind some out-houses. He did not allow the guards to turn out, or even the sentries to present arms, on the three or four occasions on which he visited part of the army, lest the enemy should see and recognise him.

At the beginning of the war he rarely took any drink except at his

meals, but latterly got into the habit of calling for a glass of port wine very often throughout the day.

The following story, which was told me by an eyewitness, will give an idea of his summary justice.

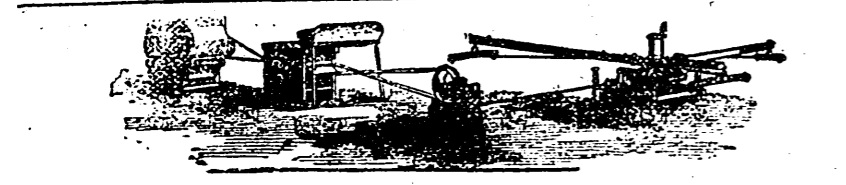
