ably remain several days until our departure would ensure them 'peace and pasture' on the plains.

I regret to say that our chief, Don Ambrosio, was obliged to leave us early this morning, owing to some pressing family affairs requiring his presence at home.

In going to the 'ground' I observed a sort of secret understanding and whispering going on amongst the Gauchos, and suspected that we of the rifles were about to be made the dupes of some practical joke or at least not treated with that consideration and courtesy which guests are entitled to.

We ascended the hill, and settled ourselves into positions, whilst the horsemen scattered themselves over the plains and valleys in every direction seeking the 'huanaçada.' I watched them patiently for an hour, and began to realize to myself the suspicions entertained in the morning.

These were at least sufficiently interesting to pass away a few hours, and served to make up for our ill-luck, for we only saw one huanaço within range during the whole morning.

Although the huanaço is a very swift animal, a good horse, and still more essential a good rider, world in fair ground almost invariably get close enough to him to use the lasso and bolas.

I should perhaps explain to the reader what sort of arm these 'bolas' are; I can only compare its form when extended to the insignia of the Isle of Man. It consists of three thongs of plaited hide, each about a yard and a half long.

These bolas are always carried ready for use, attached to the forepart of the saddle, or at the girth, and two of the thongs are doubled or folded up in zig-zag form, whilst the third or hand thong is rolled round the others and fastened with a slip-knot close up to the ball.

The German colony of Dona Francisca, in Santa Catarina, has a population of 5,237, of whom 4,503 are Protestants. Its exports in 1863 were 212,000\$ and its imports 182,000\$, respectively 40\$ and 35\$ a head.

The president thinks it must thrive when good colonists go to it, because of its fertile lands (if men were goats to climb, or beavers to swim) and its easy outlet, by the harbour of Porto Bello (by a no road, or by 90 miles of river navigable only in floods, and propensive to drowning crops and colonists), to the capital of the province, when a road is made to Porto Bello.

The German colony of Theropolis has a population of 1,694, of whom 963 are Protestants. Its exports were 28,000\$ and its imports 47,000\$, respectively 17\$ and 29\$ a head. The settlement has been decolonised. No colonists have joined it since 1864, as the useful land of the district was all absorbed.

The neighboring colony of Santa Isabel has also been decolonised. Its population is 1,268, of whom 664 are Protestants. Its exports are 23,000\$ and its imports 34,000\$. Its lands being poor, the colonists chiefly attend to grazing.

The Angelina colony has 900 souls. A church is building at a cost of 4,388\$; and 1,000\$ have been laid out on roads. The director is well lodged, but the most important settlement is "completely neglected."

CONSUMPTION OF COFFEE.

Dr. Schlosser, a Holland statistician, has made the following calculations of the consumption of coffee in various countries. He finds there has been of late years a steady and nearly general increase in its consumption by most peoples. England, however, makes an exception, where the amount consumed was in pounds:—

Dr. Schlosser attributes the great decrease perceptible between the years 1848 and 1853 to the adulteration of coffee carried on to a large extent in England. If the amount of coffee consumed with coffee were added, there would be an increase instead of a decrease.

Thus Germany and France together consume thirty-five per cent. of the whole amount, though the latter stands considerably below the former. The ratio of increase at present, however, is in favor of France, for while in Germany the consumption per head has risen in thirty years from two to four pounds, in France in the same period, it has increased from less than one pound to two pounds and a half.

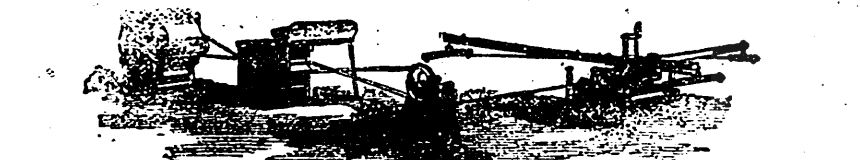

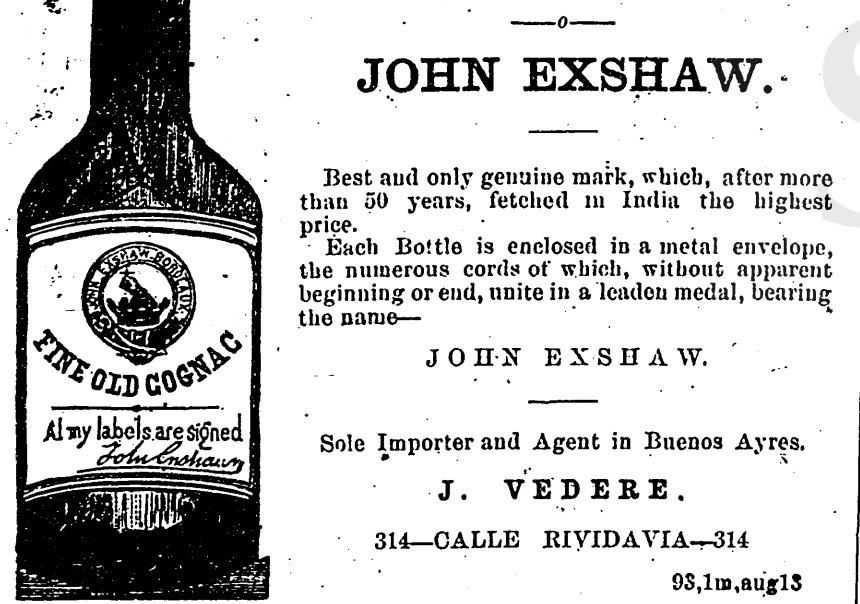

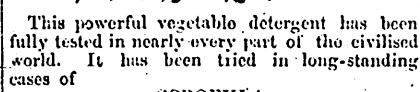
