and pre-existing rights and duties. This would ensue from the 1st project, as regards interventions in the proper sense, that is when the National Executive restores the authorities of a province at their request.

Art. 6 of our Constitution has a distinguishing characteristic: whereas the others constitute a national government, this establishes a federal bond between the provinces, with the attributes due to their own authorities and to the Federal Government.

disorder ceases, as occurred with us in the Province of Corrientes. Another difficulty in the present instance is the double term of the projects. It is proverbially easy to decline on paper the difference between insurrections against Congress and local or national rebellions, or foreign invasion; in matter of fact, however, it is often very difficult.

The revolution of Mendoza began in an outbreak of prison convicts, then the troops mutinied, after which the Governor resigned and no requisition could be made to the National Executive; finally the conflagration spread to eight provinces and devastated one-half of the Republic in the most scandalous and destructive manner.
