goods which make up the assortments of our general stores, there is a plethora of them in the towns and numerous camp stores in these parts. Merchants who are connected with these should notice this fact. There is a house in the new town of Ayacucho that is selling 'out at prices as low as the present wholesale prices in the city; and even though the director of this 'barattilo' complains that the sales are very limited. I do not wish to hint that other houses must follow so unprofitable an example, but this I can assert that there is a superabundance of goods in the camp, and a great scarcity of cash.

The epidemic among sheep, though not so severe in the Azul as in some other districts, has been general at the South. What is the cause? is the unanswered question on every tongue. Is it the rains of last summer or the dryness of winter?—is it the want of good pasture or the excess of dry grass?—is it the water they drink in cold weather, or do they not drink enough? One thing is certain, and this may help solve the difficulty, there has seldom or never been so much scab in every district, and in every flock south of the Salado. Why is there no epidemic on such estancias as that of Musgrave on the Salado, where sheep are simply bathed once or twice a year in a specific for curing scab. This system must ultimately be adopted by estancieros, and the sooner the better for them. What if the expense is considerable. The greater fatness, better wool, and larger procreation will more than compensate for the outlay. As for the old rubbing system, it would be dangerous to try it when sheep are in their present state; for the greater part of them would surely lose the tattered remnants of their covering before the process were got through.

On the whole, the epidemic is not looked upon as a calamity. Quite the contrary is the case. People seem generally impressed with the idea, that the number of sheep must be diminished, and since they are not fit for the vat, are willing to be rid of them by any other means. It is no exaggeration to say that by all small sheepfarmers, who often have to pay yearly for camp half the total value of their flocks, and by all those who are not on good fattening camps—sheep are looked upon as a nuisance. But Spring has come, and with it the much desired rain, and the probability is that there will be a general fattening among sheep. If so, there will be such an outpouring of tallow from the port of Buenos Ayres, as has never been before. People here are determined to sell or kill all those sheep that fatten before shearing. The great number of sheep killed, and still greater number that have died, the loss of wool by scab, and still greater loss by sheep that will remain unshorn, will be seen in the amount of wool produced in the coming season. I venture to predict that it will be fifteen per cent. or 25,000,000 pounds less than the amount of last year's clip. Though this may not have much influence in bettering the price of wool, considering that there are hundreds of millions of consumers, yet it will have some influence.

The taking of the census has, I believe, been accomplished. The Central Azul Commission have named a well selected staff of sub-commissioners, great formality and tact on the part of the census takers is often required to get correct answers from the suspicious gaucho. Many of them believe that the questions put to them, to use their own words 'tienen su cosa,' the mysterious 'cosa' having some vague connection with that other bug-bear, the 'sorteo.' Hints about veteran service follow, and vagaries about Paraguay, Brazil, &c., till the poor gaucho is completely muddled with undefined fears. The question 'es V. casado, ó anuecado,' is made the vehicle of gaucho wit and deceit. Yet it is to be hoped that the great numbers in the latter category will be made sufficiently evident to call the attention of reformers to the fact, that the majority of native camp people live in open defiance of shame, the generators of a race of bastards, thus sapping the source of all social virtue—then may legislators believe that the one great blessing which it is in their power to bestow upon their constituents is popular education. NEW MAP OF THE REPUBLIC. Buenos Ayres Sept. 30th 1869. To the Editors of the "Standard" Gentlemen, You were good enough to mention in your impression of Wednesday having seen the new map of the Republic constructed by Colonel Czetz and myself. I regret the gallant Colonel's name did not appear in connection with my own, as we have worked together on the map. If any merit is due, Colonel Czetz is just as much entitled to it as myself and I trust you will be good enough to give publicity to this fact. The idea of constructing the map occurred to me on commencing my late tour of inspection in the Interior, and as I had been for years collecting data I resolved to compare old notes and take new ones in districts never before visited by Geographers. With these I calculated on being able to correct the existing maps of the country all of which, without exception are most inaccurate. On my return here and being about to carry out my plan of connecting all my rough draughts and forming a complete map of those parts where I had been, and could guarantee as correct, Colonel Czetz made my acquaintance and proposed we should unite in the matter, as he possessed data of certain districts where I had never been; hence while Colonel Czetz did his share, I did mine, and he is consequently entitled to an equal share of credit, if any be due, in the production of a map—the first correct one of its class yet published. ELECTRIC CABLE TO S. AMERICA. Still another submarine telegraphic company has been formed in England. This is the West India and Panama Company, with a capital £650,000, and its purpose is to extend telegraphic communication throughout the West India Islands, and to form the central link of the telegraphic communications of Brazil, Peru, Chile, Buenos Ayres, and the other States of South America, with New York, London, and European Continent. The lines of this company, consisting of 2,550 miles of submarine cable and 350 miles of land wire, will commence in Cuba, which is now connected with the United States by the two cables of the International Ocean Telegraph Company, and be continued through the West India Islands to the continent of South America, with a branch cable to Panama. Arrangements have been made for obtaining concessions granted by Spain, securing the exclusive right, for forty years, of establishing and working telegraphic cables from Havana, through Cuba, to Port Rico and Panama, and from Porto Rico to the continent of South America through the chain of the West India Islands; and also for acquiring rights granted by the colonial governments of Jamaica, St. Thomas, Barbados, Trinidad, Demerara, for a term of ten years. Besides all this, negotiations, are in progress with the South American governments for the extension of telegraphic communication with Peru, Chile and the Argentine Confederation; and the Brazilian Government are taking steps for the extension of this company's line from Surinam to Rio Janeiro, with stations at Pernambuco, Bahia, and other ports in the route, so that the company will be in connection with lines from Rio to Buenos Ayres, Montevideo, and Valparaiso, now completed, or in course of construction. The company has made a contract with the India-rubber, Gutta-percha, and Telegraph Works Company for laying the submarine cable for the sum of £587,000. The International Exhibition of Art at Munich was opened on the 20th. Prince Adalbert was requested by the King of Prussia to act as his representative. The opening speech was delivered by Baron von Greffer, the Minister of State; Professor Knoll replied in the name of the Munich artists. The Russian Government has returned a peremptory refusal to the request of the Pope that the Russian bishops should be allowed to take part in the forthcoming Ecumenical Council at Rome. The first State Railway in India, seven and a half miles in length, has been commenced. It is to connect Khamgaon, the most flourishing mart in the Decan, with 'Nelum, on the Great Indian Peninsular Railway. The 'Moscow Gazette' states that a Jockey Club is about to be founded at St. Petersburg. It is to consist of a minimum of 500 members. The founders undertake to pay an annual subscription of 300 roubles (3s. 4d. each). Persons who may join subsequently will contribute only 150 roubles the first year, and 60 roubles subsequently. At Durrenstein, on the Danube, near the castle in which Richard Cœur de Lion is said to have been confined, an enormous granite cliff is gradually giving way, and when its fall takes place, not only the road but the river, it is feared will be choked up. An engineer is engaged on works to modify the impending mischief.

The sales for cash today were as high as yesterday, although having the coupon cut off, and the rates in force are unprecedentedly high, touching 60% for end of the year. We are told that the total number of bonds emitted does not exceed eight millions of which five millions are held by the Provincial Bank and only about three millions are in general circulation, whereas the 'ventenientos' officially noted yesterday were twelve and a half millions. It seems speculators anticipate considerable new emissions, and if Bonds go a little higher the Bank will probably throw some on the market as it is empowered to sell 20. The transactions to-day were—cash sales 14,000 at 65; for 67; 5,000 for 67; 19,000 for end of Oct. at 65; for 67; and 82,600 for end of the year, opening at 68, declining to 66, rebounding to 67, and falling at the close to 67. The 'ventenientos' were 2,000. The National Government admits a loan of 2,000,000 sterling from the Provincial Bank, which will probably form part of the 4 million bond loan (£800,000) voted by Congress for war expenses. We hope there will be no new extra duties to cut this obligation.
