the horses also being decorated with fancy coloured ribbons. The ground was in good trim, it having rained a little about a week ago. Ten competitors entered, each ploughing a 'bearing' of eight yards, when, as I have stated, Mr. C— was declared the winner, which I must say, gave general satisfaction, the more so perhaps as he was not the favourite. The judge Mr. G—, discharged his delicate task so as to please every one, even the losers were content, which says a great deal for the ability of that gentleman, as there were six of the rigs, so well up that only his great practical skill could detect the slight flaws necessary, to adjudge them 'wanting'. In the evening the competitors and spectators sat down to a substantial table, when, all justice having been done to the good cheer provided by the burxom hostess, the open hearted landlord invited us to 'glide in the merry dance' and we 'glided' until the bright rays of Aurora dispelled the shades of night. It may not be amiss here to let you know that out in this mountainous district there is an entire colony of 'Inglesees' who 'eke out' the sheepfarming by wheat farming; at every house there is to be seen from four to twelve squares under wheat, the crop this year we estimate at 350 fanegas. Out here the climate is well adapted for growing cereals, and for the last four years we have not witnessed a failure in the crops.

THE STORM. The evening of the 11th was, as you are aware, one of a very boisterous description, a very high wind and plenty of rain, enough to keep the devil at home, let alone Barraica clerks. In fact we began to think that if the 5th Oct. was wrogon predicted as the wind up of things terrestrial, the night of the 9th 11th or the 12th was sure to be. For this reason we put our house in order, lighted a good fire, set the kettle on for a comfortable cup of tea, and then commenced playing dominoes, convinced that this was as harmless a game as we could be engaged in, should any sinister occurrence take place. Matters were thus comfortably inside, though outside the storm raged, making us feel that some 'pair bodie' must find it rather hard times. About 10 p.m. the saladero and Barraica bells began to ring calling peons together. This being the general mode of arousing in the time of fires, we naturally started to our feet though convinced no fire could have the audacity to burn on such a night. The view outside was sufficient, still raining in torrents and blowing great gusts. Presently the sailors began shouting as they let go their anchors, and a turn to the edge of the river made us aware of the rising of the river. Being rather higher situated than most of the Barraicas we had no fear of immediate danger, so returning in again and finishing our game we dispersed for the evening, prepared however, for any emergency that should occur during the night.

The morning of the 12th dawned upon us gloomy as was expected, with drizzling rain, and the wind still high. Vessels that the night before were laying alongside the moles, were hauled out into midchannel with anchors set and ropes fastening them securely to the shore. As far as the eye could see, looking from our 'azotea' nothing presented itself but a vast sheet of water, and houses like little islands dotting its surface. Guns were firing in all directions calling our boats to lend their aid in the rescue of families flooded out of their houses, some even taking to the roofs. Carcasses of drowned pigs, sheep, dogs, cats, hens, rats, and even a poor duck were to be seen floating up the river, besides any quantity of offal from the adjacent saladeros. After breakfast I started along the line to take a view of the neighbourhood.

At the Barraca of Messrs. Hughes and Co. all was safe, the river still wanting a good deal to overrun the rails of the line. At Ballesteros, the clerks, headed by an indefatigable Englishman recently returned from Paraguay, along with several peons were busily engaged stemming a current of water which threatened to enter the Barraca, succeeding in which they retired inside, but not before being warned that said important embarkment might be opened upon them if it threw the water back on the premises of the English firm before mentioned. Subsequent events did not occasion such a proceeding being put into action, consequently no alterations ensued.

way people passing the train along for fear of being precipitated into the 'lake below. Rats here abounded and the poor animals half drowned emerging from their flooded tenements became an easy prey to a few superior 'raters', who along with their enthusiastic owners, were evidently enjoying the sport, some were more knowing than others, and had climbed up the trees lining the bank, and perched on the branches like birds, looked down on their enemies with extreme satisfaction until discovered; when they too fell victims to the devouring elements.

Several industrions Italians not over well fed, though certainly full of stature were busily employed fishing out bits of timber, possibly with an eye to cook their 'macaroni' while two in particular, it might have been from a relationship to the departed spirit, were quarrelling for the remains of a sucking pig. I passed on to the Peña station, and there met my friend Brown, who had just been measuring the number of feet of water in the hold. He was evidently thinking on the liting, but I believe held out to the last as the train ran past all day.
