NEW NATURALIZATION LAW. CHAP. I. Argentines. Art. 1. All those born in the Republic, no matter of what nationality their parents may have been.

Art. 2. The children of Argentines, who although born abroad may select citizenship of their parents' country.

Art. 3. Those born in the Legations, of war vessels of the Republic.

Art. 5. Those who settle on the frontiers or outside of them.

Art. 6. Foreigners fulfilling the before mentioned conditions may obtain letters of naturalization from the Sectional Federal Judge before whom they appear.

Art. 7. Argentines of eighteen years of age enjoy political rights as laid down by the Constitution and the laws of the Republic.

Art. 8. The following do not enjoy political rights in the Republic: Those naturalized in a foreign country.

Art. 9. Children of native born Argentines, born abroad, must declare before the Federal Judge their status as children of Argentines.
