STATISTICS AND RESOURCES. The Tribuna of Montevideo publishes the following reliable calculations...

The live stock of the Republic is put down as follows: 10,000,000 cows at \$5... 1,000,000 horses at \$6... 100,000 mules at \$6... 10,000,000 sheep at 60 cents... 150,000 goats, &c. at \$2...

The 'Contribution' collected in 1866 amounted to \$414,191; if we deduct the portion hereof that was levied off live-stock, \$215,379, we find a balance of \$198,812 proceeding from houses and lands...

Taking the live-stock in proportion to the area at present occupied (5,500 sq. leagues) we find each square of the Republic has the following: 1818 cows, 291 horses, 18 mules, 1818 sheep, 28 goats, representing a total value of 13,6178.

FOREIGN NEWS. The Daily News observes that 'the crucial test of the policy of the new administration will be the mode of dealing with the question of electoral reform.'

MONTEVIDEO. Monday. The Government continues to suffer the most furious attacks from the opposition papers. An article in the La Raz proclaims all the public authorities to be "a gang of thieves," for which the Fiscal has commenced a state-prosecution; Don José P. Varela has declared himself author of the article, and a jury is empanelled of which Messrs. Lafone, Tomkinson junr, and others are members. The Siglo has an article against Minister Bustamante in a similar strain, and says he aspires to a Dictatorship. At present the state of things is so lawless in town and camp that it would be well to make Ramirez, Bustamante, Batlle or somebody Dictator for 3 months with power to hang the malefactors that cause the present Reign of Terror.

From Cerrito Largo we heard of 18 immigrants families being located as farmers on a great of 240 acres. Sr. Villamil hopes the Government will mark out a number of 'chocoras' for agricultural purposes. Don Toronado Marquinez is building a flour-mill. A bank is much needed in the town of Melo; also a high-road, with bridges, to communicate with Rio Grande. Mr. Alexander Bailla has petitioned in exporting live cattle to Europe; the Junta of Public Credit seems to entertain the matter favorably, notwithstanding the impetuosity of the public treasury. If the business turn out well it will be grand thing for the River Plate, and especially for Banda Oriental.

Advices of a flattering nature still come from Cotiapirí, which is now represented as a second California, but the general public are not enthusiastic in the matter. The Mexicans have a proverb "If a man finds mud on his hand he gets rich, if silver it makes him poor, but if gold he is ruined." The Gefe of Nazario has captured a band of robbers 10 in number, viz: Nazario Zapata, Felipe Zapata, Juliadoro Huerta, Pascual Huerta, Benito Garcia, Pablo Frías, Manuel Armá, Alcibar Santos, N. Romero, Pablo Gann. These fellows had a place in the woods where they slaughtered large quantities of stolen cattle and staked out the hides. Two shopkeepers named Pio Arzola and Manuel Fernandez have also been imprisoned at Durazno for buying the hides from the brigands. Regular gangs of robbers are known to exist in Minas, Cerro Largo and other departments, who commit daring burglaries and murders with entire impunity. From Rio Janeiro we hear that there are 100 cases daily of yellow fever, but not more than about 10 deaths. All vessels now arriving from Brazil are sent to Flores island, where the Sr. Lazzarotto has been provided with 200 beds. M. Gououilh has erected a slip for repairing vessels that draw less than 10ft. of water. It is thought that the fire in Calle Bacacay was the work of an incendiary. The city mortality yesterday was—three foreigners and 1 child. On Saturday night the police arrested a man who was climbing up to a 2nd story balcony by a ladder of ropes. A number of vagabonds and robbers about town is alarming. Last week Sr. Freyre, chief clerk in the War Department, discovered some fellows hiding in the walls of a house that is being built alongside his own, but they escaped without his catching them. Next day they left a note in the same place to this effect: "If you do not leave us to-morrow \$100 in this place we will murder you and all your family." Mr Freyre watched all night but the fellows did not appear. Nothing more is known about the affair of the Goodman, but it is probable the British Consul will complain about the ruffians who boarded the vessel sword in hand under the pretext of salvage. It seems some pilots have towed her up to Buenos Ayres. The wool and sheepskins will be sold to-morrow.

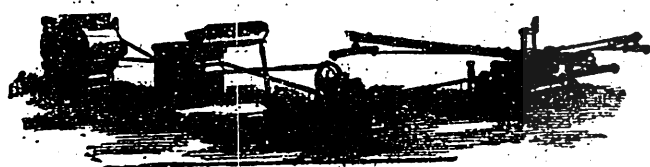

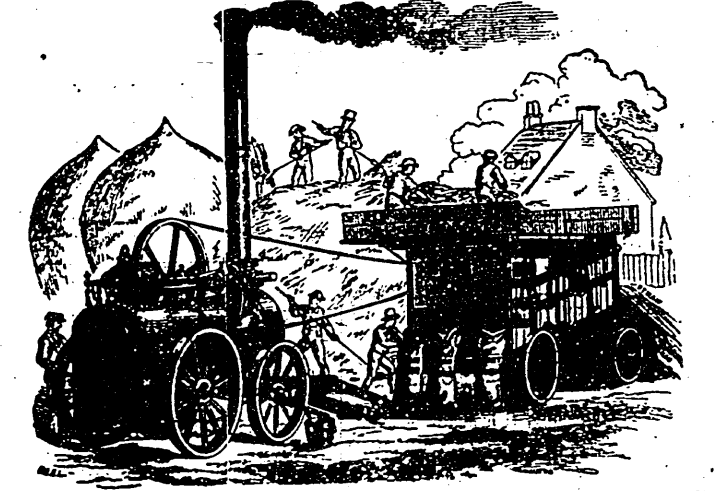
