FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE EPIZOOTIC APHTHA SYMPTOMS.

The disease is invariably characterized by a brief period of incubation, varying from twenty-four hours to three to four days. It is ushered in by a shivering fit, and a vesicular eruption occurs in the month and on the digits; in female animals also on the teats. There is a tendency also in young animals, especially such as are sucking or drinking milk, to a similar eruption on the fauces and pharynx, with irritation of the larynx and of the whole digestive tube.

The eruption in the mouth is first indicated by smacking of the lips and salivation, and loss of power from the prehension and mastication of food. The pain is evidently intense, and on opening the mouth vesicles are found about the size of a bean or hazel nut. They are sometimes congregated in patches on the inner surface of the lips and cheeks, on the tongue, and occasionally on the schneiderian membrane.

In about thirteen hours the vesicles burst, and the red painful spots thus exposed are soon covered with epithelium in favorable cases, whereas in others ulcers develop.

When the eruption occurs on the mammae the teats are sore and swollen; vesicles also form in the mouth; they are large and well-raised from the surface of the skin, never umbilicated or pustular; they contain a clear fluid and soon burst or draw up, so that in five or six days their scales cover the spots where the vesicles have existed.

All symptoms of fever in favorable cases subside by the fourth day, the appetite restored, and convalescence well established by the eighth day. Complications are not unfrequent; the fever runs high, ulceration spreads, the animal becomes exhausted, the hoofs slough off, the blood becomes impure and death occurs about the ninth or tenth day. In the year 1863 a great number of cases occurred in Holland and the United Kingdom, and in Scotland many dairies suffered heavy losses from this disease.

Special symptoms in different animals.—In cattle, the constant driving, blood-shot eyes, quick breathing, accelerated pulse, arched back and difficulty to stand are the leading signs of the disease. When it attacks a lot of dairy cows great inconvenience to the farmer and danger to the animal arise from the eruption on the teats. In sheep the emaciation is considerable; they cannot eat, and they move about with difficulty. The injury to the feet is the most serious complication in a flock, and chronic disorders frequently arise from the unhealthy ulcers.

In pigs the disease is characterized by considerable fever and pain; the animals scream as they move about and clamp with their jaws. It has been asserted that the disease originates spontaneously, more readily in the pig than in any other animal; that the communication of this disease from one country to another depends chiefly on the pigs driven to market by dealers. The communication of the disease to man admits of no doubt. The history of various outbreaks of it demonstrates this. There have been many contradictory statements of the matter, but the symptoms repeatedly noticed in man after drinking the milk of diseased cows are unmistakable.

The Mendoza people if they are sincere in their efforts about immigration, would do well to first arrange with M. Matti about supplying immigrants with passage on his steamers to Rosario.

A portion of the building materials for the Cordoba Exhibition has arrived at Rosario and are now discharging at the railway wharf, tomorrow they will be forwarded by rail to Cordoba.

In the far south fully three-fourths of the estancias are held in this manner. In the north and west of this province estancias lands have a certain marketable value, from 25,000 to 50,000 per legua, but few sales have been effected in the South. The Suarez estancia is in the Arroyo Cristiano, well stocked, and has been known down there as a place of importance. The sheep, horses and horned cattle, will be sold with the estancia.

The Banco del Pueblo, which is a new concern, has taken temporary offices between Wanklyn's Bank and the Bolea. No better site could be had. The statutes and by laws have been duly sanctioned, and we suppose the bank will now make a start. The very splendid success of the Argentine Bank shows what can be done under a good and economic management. The founders of the Banco del Pueblo are men of wide connection and good position. The nominal capital of this new concern is two million patacons.
