Marrieta's hands for account of the Argentine Government the enormous sum of £2,311,000, or something over £11 million hand dollars."

"Why does all this money remain in London, instead of coming out to Buenos Ayres?"

"There must be some cause at the bottom, or else the detention of these funds, while we are paying interest and amortization here, is beyond all patience. Perhaps the loan is not really for the benefit of the country, and that the loan is not all gone, unless we are to suppose that Marrieta laid over the money to Dr. Varela, and that the latter retains it, which is ridiculous."

"Hence it appears the loan may have been negotiated but is not yet realized. On this point the National Government is bound to enlighten the public more precisely than in the vague terms of the Message."

"When Dr. Van-la broke up the engagements with Thomson, Hour, & Co., and also the negotiations with Messrs. Cohen, was he really instructed by his government to arrange for only a part of the loan, while charging commission on the whole? We understand he was."

"But it seems Marrieta held back the operation, with the hope of obtaining higher prices, and this disgraced many people. Mr. Robertson sold his stock, £0,000, on the London Stock Exchange, and wrote to Marrieta washing his hands out of the business, and handing them to the man obtained in selling his Bonds. This suffices to show the state of things."

"The loan was not omitted at 83, but at really a much higher figure, to the benefit of the bankers, who must oblige us to pay a high interest on sums we have not received."

"The foregoing remarks have attracted much attention among our bondholders, but the statement upon the whole urges little weight, inasmuch as those who are well informed in the matter know its whole history."

"The Southern Railway works are suspended within four leagues of Carmen las Flores. It is said some of the estancieros refuse the ground, unless they get a free ticket in perpetuity for their families. The Provincial Chambers is at present debating a bill to prolong the Southern Railway simultaneously to Azul and Dolores, giving the S. R. Co. a subsidy of £500 a mile on condition both branches be finished in three years, and that Government may buy up the branches at £7,200 per mile. We believe the cost will not exceed half that figure, but the Company will hardly consent to expropriation."

An Englishman arrived from Azul brings us important news from that district, which has been thrown into the greatest alarm by a recent rupture with the Indians. It appears there is an extradition treaty with the Caciques for the surrender of fugitive murderers. Some time since the authorities sent a requisition to Catriel for an individual of this class, but the Indian chief refused to give him up. Hereupon the National Government stopped the supplies of provisions which are periodically allowed the various tribes. The Indians then approached Azul in a threatening attitude, and many of the shop-keepers and others were thinking of a hasty evacuation, when opportune reinforcements arrived, and a skirmish took place with the Indians in which the latter were worsted."
