Buenos Ayres, August 28, 1871. To the Hon. Chamber of Deputies. The Executive begs to submit the Budget for 1872, for approval of your Chamber.

The Executive is glad to present now for the first time in one sheet a complete statement of the national finances, on which Congress can form the most accurate conclusions.

The estimates of EXPENDITURE amount to \$28,610,038 fcs., viz:— Interior \$5,557,492 Foreign affairs 121,172

This exceeds the figures for last year by \$1,111,381 fcs., but if we deduct the item of the Rio Cuarto Railway, the above total will be reduced to \$26,810,038, which is less than last year's estimates by \$688,619 fcs.

In view of so great a deficit the Government may adopt one of two courses, either reduce the expenditure or increase the taxes. A temporary expedient might be devised by using our credit, and this the Government thinks most advisable.

To increase the taxes would be still more difficult and injurious, for, if we consider the condition of the tax-payers we shall find that we have imposed on them as much as they can reasonably pay.

Hence the Government inclines to use our credit to make good the deficit, as a temporary remedy. The estimates of Ways and Means are:— Import duties 10,400,000 Additional 5 per cent. 2,600,000

The Ways and Means for 1871 were calculated at a figure almost equal to the above, but the Plague upset all our estimates, and even if we are spared a return of it we can hardly expect the revenue will exceed what we had put down for 1871.

Imports form our largest income, and we have preserved the same figure of \$10,400,000 as estimated for last year; the effects of the Plague have certainly paralyzed trade in Buenos Ayres, but on the other hand the re-establishment of peace in the other Provinces will give elasticity to our commerce, and we may hope for improved health in the city seeing that the authorities are about to remove the principal origin of the recent Plague.

We have on hand \$1,800,000 for the Rio Cuarto Railway, which we include in the estimates merely to balance the accounts. Finally we can raise \$7,000,000 ft. between the Provincial Bank and the market; we were able to raise even a larger sum during the pressure of the Plague, and now when Government bills are at a premium there can be no difficulty.

Meantime it is likely we shall be spared the necessity of using our credit, for two reasons; 1st perhaps the whole of the 30 millions will not be realized this year, in which case we shall not have to pay so much interest, for the Budget includes the whole of it; 2ndly, at the end of 1872 there will be a large floating debt, the amount of which we cannot now determine.

With the revenues above expressed the Government will be able to pay its way, if you approve of the annexed Budget:— Art. 1. The Budget for 1872 is fixed at \$28,610,038 fcs. to be distributed as follows:—

EDITOR'S TABLE. The Budget for 1872 has been at last presented to Congress by the Finance Minister. The deficit between the estimated expenditure and the ways and means to meet it is calculated by Mr. Dominguez at very nearly 7,000,000 patacons, which he proposes to meet by new loans, and the sale of 17,000 shares which the country holds in the Central Argentine Railway.

In another column will be found the list of entries for the Lanuz Races, on the 8th prox. We are glad to notice so good a bill of fare, and share in the general anticipation that the meeting will prove a great success.

A desperate and unprovoked attempt at assassination took place on the Flores road on Monday. The facts, as related to us by an English gentleman, who was walking along the Western Railway line at the moment, are as follow:—A peon out of employment went about midday to where a gang of men were at work on the tramway near Caballito, and asked to be allowed to work.

Every bottle of soda-water that is opened, every candle that is burnt, every paper cigar that is smoked, and every match that is used to light them, all add to the formation of carbonic acid gas, and up to the present moment I have always understood that it is a recognized fact that by no operation in nature is carbonic acid gas destroyed, but by vegetation.

Parliament has directed the establishment of a special fund for paying the dividends on and redeeming the principal of this stock; and the Lords of Her Majesty's Treasury control the sum to be raised annually by the Consolidated Rate for this purpose.

Before proceeding to open the tenders the Board will, with the approval of Her Majesty's Treasury, fix the minimum price, below which no tender will be accepted; and in the event of an amount in the excess of £900,000 sterling being offered above such minimum price, the tenders at the lowest price accepted will be subject to a prorata diminution.

The arrangements for the extra traffic on the Northern Railway caused by the auction sales at Belgrano on Sunday were most satisfactory, Mr. Crutcher, the general manager, superintending them in person.

The lottery for 1000 ounces and 200 lots of land in the Busbenthal quinta has been postponed till Tuesday next; it was to have come off last Saturday in Montevideo.

Business in the upper provinces is reported as in general very dull.

Dr. Quintana, who purchased the bulk of the White Chacra at Belgrano last year for \$400,000 currency, made 900,000 dollars by the auction on Sunday last, the lots sold having realized \$1,300,000 mc.

The news from San Luis received yesterday is of a very unsatisfactory character. The Indians are said to have lately made a raid to within a few leagues of the chief town of that province, carrying off several captives and a number of horned cattle.

The Patagonia, from the West Coast, sailed for Liverpool from Montevideo on Monday; the mails from Buenos Ayres were in time to catch her.

The following highly interesting statistics of the murders committed in England and Wales in ten years were handed to us yesterday by an English subscriber.

"Sir George Jenkinson's return of the murders committed in England and Wales in the ten years between 1861 and 1870 has been presented to the House of Commons.

There has been another fight in the Baudia Oriental. Salvamach, the Blanco chief whose forces routed the Reds under Fidelis last week, has been defeated; some say killed, and his men cut up by the Colorado stragglers who collected again after their reverse.

The removal of the late General Urquiza's remains from their temporary resting place to the church took place at Concepcion on the 25th inst.

The budget of the National Minister of Hacienda was the subject of great remark on Change to-day, as Congress has already passed the law authorizing the Government to nego-

ciate a loan with the Provincial Bank for six million patcoons, the deficit will be reduced to 900,000 patcoons, which will be met by treasury bills in this market. The expenditure for the ensuing fiscal year would, it appears, be under that of last year but that the cost of the Rio Cuervo Railway is included. The budget, it must also be borne in mind, includes for the first time all the expenditures, both ordinary and extraordinary, which is a decided improvement upon the old system.

Mr. Don Luis A. Martinez presented on Saturday night to the Provincial Legislature the following measure which, as there is a large majority in its favor in the Chambers, will, it is thought, at once pass both houses and become law. The following is the project of law— Art. 1. Let the Provincial Bank be authorized to make an emission of two hundred millions of paper money.

The project meets with the highest approbation in commercial circles, but there are many who consider that the emission should be fifty millions of patcoons, instead of eight millions. Public opinion is now divided on this question of a mortgage bank; many are more in favor of Sr. Balbino's scheme, which authorizes the bank to emit interest bearing certificates to represent the amount of each mortgage concluded by the bank.

On and after the 1st of next month the City of Buenos Ayres Tramway Company will cease to redeem the old tickets, as up to the present it has done. This, it is said, will cause a saving to the Company of about \$2,000 mjc per month.
