MURDER OF AN IRISHMAN IN SANTA FE.

Rosario, August 24, 1871. To the Editors of the STANDARD.

Knowing the great interest the STANDARD takes in the welfare of this our adopted country, and that you are not afraid to let the truth be known, I take the liberty of addressing you a few lines on the great shortcomings of some of the authorities in the province of Santa Fe.

It is but a few days ago that one of our countrymen was barbarously murdered within 200 yards of his own house, and about 150 of that of a comisario. The victim's name was John Leary, a hard-working industrious man, living on the camp of Don Domingo Sapauro.

The following is the statement made by Leary before he died, for the unfortunate man lived some 25 or 30 hours after receiving the wound. On the evening of the 16th of August he went down to the Arroyo Seco to give his horse water, as was his usual custom, when two men came up to him, both entirely unknown to him, and asked for a good pass in the arroyo; he showed them where to pass, which they did, and when on the other side one of them began to abuse him, calling him a 'gringo,' and commenced to repress the arroyo. Leary was at this time on foot, with the bit out of his horse's mouth, giving him water. He told the fellow to keep back or he would shoot him, at the same time drawing his revolver. The gaucho came nearer, and Leary pulled the trigger, but the pistol missed the fire. At the same moment he received a blow on the head from a
