Montevideo, Sept. 11. To the Editors of the STANDARD, Gentlemen: At risk of boring your readers, I cannot allow the critique on Rossi's 'Hamlet,' in your edition of yesterday, to pass without a few remarks, as it appears to me to convey a very erroneous impression as to the merits of the actor.

His conception of the character is conventional in the extreme—conventional after the style one used to witness at the 'Rial Vic,' in the New Cut—or where it is not so, and he relies on his own unaided genius, it is bombastic and incoherent; passion is in such 'torn to tatters, by very rage,' in such a manner that would serve to dissipate any doubts hitherto held by dissenting commentators as to his being in truth a veritable lunatic.

Would it surprise you to interview a ghost who wears a scarlet cloak? One would think this would be sufficient to appal the stoutest, but Rossi is not so other men. It is true his cap falls off (still conventional) at the appearance of such a wondrous apparition, but otherwise he maintains comparatively an equable aspect; nor is he any happier in the delivery of the famous soliloquy, which is 'poor indeed,' in short it is not a soliloquy at all, but simply an address to the 'gods.'

As regards the use of the miniature portrait, Rossi makes not such an error as your correspondent states; in this he only follows the precedent of Fechter, and this introduction was commended by good critics, as well as the general performance of this last named actor, which was indeed something to witness.

Your correspondent admits that the whole play is cut up and rejointed by the translator. This there can be no dispute about, and I do not see how, in such a case, an actor can make the remotest approach to a clear idea of the Hamlet of Shakespeare.

THE NATIONAL BANK. To the Editors of the STANDARD, Gentlemen, Judging from your report of the speech made by Mr. Beutze in the Senate yesterday on the above subject, that gentleman appears to have a wrong idea respecting the assistance received by the Bank of England from the Government.

When the Bank of Brazil refused to cash their notes in 1858, it was urged in their defence that the Bank of England had also just suspended specie payments, and, judging from the above-mentioned speech in the Senate, this strangely erroneous idea of the Bank of England and the English Government in 1847 and 1857 seems still to exist.

On both those occasions the Government partially suspended a law which prevented the Bank from making use of the tons of gold lying idle in its vaults. Though notes were made use of as more convenient, the act was in fact a permission to pay out gold, and no idea of any suspension of specie payments was ever entertained.

The act simply enabled the Bank Directors to extend their discounts, at their own risk and discretion, and without any privilege not enjoyed by any other bill discounters, more than under existing restrictive laws they could otherwise have done.

THE BOND MARKET continues weak, and prices fall off for the month still further today. Only 5,000 were sold at 71; for Saturday 20,000 at 71; for September 30 25,000 at 71; closing at 71; for October 31 10,000 at 71; deliverable for 31st December 10,000 at 72.

At San Fernando the beautiful quinta of Mr. Drabble has been sold for three hundred thousand dollars to Mr. Murga. The magnificent quinta of Benavente, at Quilmes, 105 squares of land, with fine house &c., has been purchased by Don Lyandro Billinghurst for the round sum of \$1,200,000.

Several large and important land sales in the district of Quilmes have been effected during the last month. Messrs. Bate, Bagley, Walker and others have purchased largely in the neighbourhood, and as the railway from Barracas will soon be commenced, and the saladeros are about to move 'en masse' to Ensenada, it is thought that Quilmes property is susceptible of much improvement.

Here it is just the contrary: competent persons are extremely scarce, and they dictate their terms to please their own interests; at least this occurs whenever works are to be undertaken in the interior provinces.
