The thermometer rose considerably yesterday, quite a spring temperature prevailing. The signs of rain apparent on Tuesday passed away, much to the disappointment of agriculturists and sheepfarmers, who are all seriously uneasy at the prolonged drought.

The death of Don Manuel Toboada in Santiago del Estero, which was announced by all our morning colleagues on Tuesday, has been officially contradicted. This is, if we remember rightly, the third time Don Manuel has been sent to 'another and a better world' by Dame Rumour within the last six months.

Some excitement was caused yesterday afternoon in the Plaza Once de Septiembre by Mr. Zamborain taking round for signature a petition for the removal of the market from the Plaza to San José de Flores. The idea found little favor amongst the leading men at the Once, and the brokers fairly gasped for breath at the John Gilpin prospect before them on Saturdays during the wool season, if the market were removed. We cannot think that a removal of the Once market to Flores would be an improvement, or conducive to the interests of the business community.

Yesterday morning the leading gang of workmen on the Flores tramway reached the plaza of that charming town. The rails are now laid down the entire way, and the public inauguration of the line is only a matter of a few weeks' delay.

The Government has still under consideration the two projects presented to it by the Municipality of Belgrano for lighting that rising town with gas. One is by Dr. Olguin, the other by Sr. M. Alvarez de Arenales.

Whatever may have been the motives which have induced Peru to turn her attention to those allments of the Amazon which place her transandine provinces in connection with the Atlantic, certain it is that all such attempts must in some way or other be a benefit, sooner or later, to the aboriginal tribes—tribes important for their number, and with qualities powerful for good or evil.

Some of the pictures Villagencio gives of Indian life on the banks and regions of the Napo and other rivers leading into the Matraira are at once novel and interesting. He calculates the whole number of the different tribes at 200,000. Of these tribes, some are indolent and others are industrious; some seek the white man, while others fly his presence.

Thus, when the fruit trees of the Cordillera have yielded their tribute to men and animals, there is a new harvest ready for them on the banks of the Amazon. This result not only encourages a nomadic life among the animals, but also among the Indians; the former following up the ripening of the fruits, and the latter doing the same, and adding to this supply that of hunting and fishing.

In view of the immense number of Indians that inhabit the territories which the states of South America have divided between them, it becomes a serious and important problem which is the best mode of even beginning to bring them within the pale of civilization. It would be worth while to take into consideration the plan suggested by Sr. Villacencio in his work, of calling in the aid of the Jesuits. In the United States the law of force means extermination, and the aid of the Quakers, who were appealed to lately, has accomplished little. The expulsion of the Jesuits from the forests of America has been as fruitful in evil as was the expulsion of the Moors from Spain or the Huguenots from France.

The Paraguyan Indians are verging into civilization,—the Indians of the Ecuadorian and Peruvian headwaters of the Amazon are to-day what they were three hundred years ago. We certainly think the Peru worthy the consideration of both Peru, Ecuador and Bolivia. The former has funds and facilities, and even one tribe reclaimed becomes an inducement for others to follow.

The ruins of their missions still retain their name, and the Indians remember the Padres as their best friends. About the middle of the 15th century, the Spaniards had established three flourishing cities and thirty mining villages in the region between Quito and the Amazon, Mendoza, Sevilla del Oro and Logroño, but the bad treatment of the Indians kept pace with Spanish prosperity, until the Jivaros Indians, with an army of 20,000, sacked and destroyed the latter, carrying away prisoners, all the other towns and establishments were forthwith abandoned, their remains and sites are now lost, buried as it were in the dense cinnamon forests, which gave a name to the region as "los paisés de la cañela."
