The Amazone Mails.

London, Sept. 20. The autumn campaign in Berkshire goes bravely on, and for miles around Aldershot the country has been in all the throes of mimic warfare.

The result of the fighting in connection with the autumn manoeuvres yesterday was that the attacking forces of Sir Charles Staveley and General Carey were repulsed by the forces under the command of Sir Hopton Grant.

The failure of the potato crop has caused much distress in several quarters; the general trade of the country, however, is satisfactory.

The Emperor and Empress of Brazil are making a succession of flying visits to the chief cities and towns of Germany. A medal has just been struck at the Brussels Mint to commemorate the visit of the Emperor to Belgium.

The fatal cases of cholera during the week ending the 17th instant exceeded all previous weeks. Over 300 deaths occurred; the usual proportion of 50 to 60 per cent. of deaths having risen to 70 to 80 per cent.

According to the latest official returns, the number of individuals attacked by cholera in the Baltic provinces amounted to 2,517 civilians up to the 10th inst.; and 84 soldiers. Of these 1,273 died, 620 recovered, and 708 remained under treatment.

The department of the Seine at Oise is totally evacuated, and other three are nearly clear of German troops. The manifestations by French people led to some disturbances on Sunday evening at St. Denis.

The Times' Paris correspondent telegraphs that within the next few days the President of the Republic will install himself with some of his ministers at Fontainebleau.

All night long the rain descended with tropical violence, but the morning broke in cloudless splendour. On arriving we had set our horses at liberty, and they were by this time 'run back again to their 'querencia' (as the place where they are domiciled is called)...

The shepherd whom we had met in the palm forest informed us that scarce a night passed in which he did not lose one or more sheep from his flock, and promised to guide us to the spot which a 'lioness' with her two cubs was said to haunt...

Having reached a spot which appeared to be a likely find for game, we hobbled the horses, taking the additional precaution of lashing them by the 'soga' or tether, as horses when alarmed will often move to a considerable distance even with the fore feet tied together...

and of the lagoon on the other, Don Manuel entered the thicket from behind, so as to force out the pumas into the open plain, and had nearly worked his way through it, when our new acquaintance, who was seated on horseback near the outside, pointed out a movement among the bushes, and presently one of the cubs appeared stealing quietly away, and so intent on watching the dogs that it was unconscious of other danger...

The floods subsided with the same rapidity with which they had risen, and on the morrow, resisting all the hospitable importunities of our host, we continued our journey. The easy amble of the horses disguised the length of the way, and we passed on without incident till we halted to rest at noon, on the banks of a sluggish stream...
