Again, as to the Alexandra colony being 'after all a most useless undertaking,' if a place bonded on two sides by rivers and on one side by a neighboring colony, and consequently having only one side open, so to speak, and having good communication with important centres of commerce, over fifty able colonists, and a hundred stand of arms, be risky, then, and only then, will the Alexandra colony fall under that category.

Lastly, it is perfectly true, that 'to put inexperienced colonists inside the Indian territory is to consign them to certain destruction and the enterprise to certain ruin.'
