The ex-king Francis d'Assisi continues to reside in Switzerland, separated from Isabella and from all his former courtiers, reduced to great poverty.

The Spanish Academy on the 12th January elected the Emperor of Brazil an honorary member.

Admiral Topete had succeeded in getting his friend the Marquis of Havana appointed Viceroy of Cuba, but the last advices from Count Balboa in the final suppression of the revolt have induced Government to yield to the popular clamor and keep

Balmaceda in his post.
